This prestigious co-educational institution aims at intellectually mature, morally upright, socially committed and spiritually inspired young men and women who can play an effective role in the background of the rich heritage of our democratic motherland.





Bishop Moore College, Mavelikara, established in 1964 and affiliated to the University of Kerala, has been awarded A grade by NAAC in the 3rd cycle of accreditation and ranked 76 among the Colleges in India in the NIRF ranking 2020. The College offers 11 five postgraduate and two research undergraduate, programmes in Science, Commerce, Arts and Humanities along with two UGC-sponsored add-on courses, and also provides opportunities for students to carry out Summer Research Projects at reputed institutes in the country.
