3. The 80.85% pass in BA English and 100% pass in MA English was mentioned as praiseworthy.

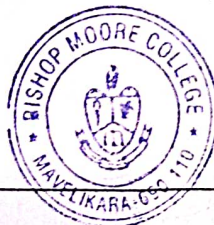
