No. of Responses Received : 133


Nature of Questionnaire:

Observations and Analysis:


1. Facilities in the classroom

An analysis of the facilities in the classroom was made and 3 % of the students suggested that the facilities should be improved and 97% were satisfied or more.




2. Library facilities

An analysis of the library facilities was made and 97 % of the students mentioned that the Library provided required amenities. 3% suggested scope for improvement.




3. Laboratory facilities

An analysis of the laboratory facilities was made and 98% of the students said that the Laboratory met the requirements.




4. Service of the teaching staff

An analysis of the Service of the teaching staff was made and 84% of the students mentioned that the teachers were very good or more. 11% expressed that teachers were good.




5. Service in college office

An analysis of the Service of the college office was made and 97% of the students mentioned that the service of college office was satisfied or more.




6. Voluntary Activities (NCC, NSS, etc...)

An analysis of the voluntary activities was made and 85% of the students mentioned that the voluntary activities were Very Good or Excellent.




7. Sports and Games

Sports and Games provided by the college was made and 96% of the students mentioned that the sports and Games facilities was satisfied or more.




8. Women's Centre/Recreation Facilities

An analysis of the women's centre and 85% of the students mentioned that the service of college office was satisfied or more.




9. Activities of PTA

Activities of PTA provided by the college were made and 83% of the students mentioned that the Activities of PTA was Very Good or Excellent.




10. Bookstall

Bookstall provided by the college was analysed and 83% of the students mentioned that the Bookstall was Very Good or Excellent.




11. Canteen

An Analysis of the Computer centre/Career guidance & Counselling centre Of the College were made and 94 % said that it was good or very good or excellent.




13. Environmental Activities

An Analysis of the Computer Environmental activities was done and 98 % expressed that it was more than satisfactory.




14. Safety in the campus

15. Waste Disposal Mechanism


An Analysis of the waste disposal system of the College was made and only 5% of the students were dissatisfied.



ALUMNI


1. I feel proud to be an alumnus of Bishop Moore College

The alumni of the institution were asked about their pride of being a part of the college and 83% of the respondents were Very happy.




2. The learning I had in the college is useful in my career

The alumni of the institution were asked whether the lessons at college were productive for them and 91% of the respondents were agreed to it.57% strongly agreed to it.




3. The development of the college in the recent years is appreciative

89% of the alumni respondents strongly agreed to the fact that the college was developing according to the changing needs of the society.




4. The new courses introduced meet contemporary requirements

97% of the alumni respondents agreed to the fact that the new courses introduced in college was according to the changing needs of the industry.




5. The college is involving alumni in its activities

89% of the alumni respondents agreed to the fact that the college was taking steps to promote Alumni activities. 11% were neutral to it.




6. The alumni have a role to play in academic and financial strength of the college

7. The college is actively communicating its activities to the alumni


91 % were neutral or agreed and 9% of the respondents of alumni disagreed to the activities engaged by college involving alumni.


1. Facilities in the classroom

Only 3% of the faculties rated below good in terms of facilities available in classroom.




2. Library Facilities

97% of the faculties rated better than satisfactory in terms of facilities available at library.




3. Laboratory Facilities

94 % of the faculties rated above very good in terms of facilities available in laboratory




4. Adequateness of Curriculum

Only 3% of the faculties rated below satisfactory in terms of curriculum adequacy 84 % mentioned above Very Good.




5. Service in college office

97 % of the faculties were happy with the services of the office in college and 3% suggested improvement.




6. Voluntary Activities

78 % of the faculties said that voluntary activities at the college was excellent and6 % were of the opinion that it needed improvement.




7. Sports and Games

97 % of the faculties were happy with the sports and games offered in college and 6% were only satisfied.




8. Women's Centre/Recreation Facilities

88 % of the faculties were happy with the PTA activities and 54% was of the opinion that it was Excellent.




10. Bookstall

66 % of the faculties were very happy with the Canteen Facilities and 28 % was of the opinion that it was good and 16% were neutral or dissatisfied.




12. Computer centre/Career guidance & Counseling centre

94 % of the faculties rated the above facilities as very good and 6% was of the opinion that these facilities were good and none were dissatisfied.




13. Environmental Activities

All the faculties were highly satisfied with Safety at the college campus. 86% rated it excellent.




15. Waste Disposal Mechanism

Waste Disposal Mechanism of the college was asked to faculties and 86% of the respondents were very happy or more




1. Programme Objectives and Syllabi are challenging

88% of the employers strongly agreed to it and none of the employers were dissatisfied.




2. The objectives are clear and specific

100% of the employers agreed to it and 82~% strongly agree that objectives were clear and specific.




3. The objectives are realistic

100% of the employers agreed to it and 88~% strongly agree that objectives were realistic




4. The internal evaluation can be done effectively

88% of the employers agreed to it and 12 % are neutral to internal evaluation




5. The syllabus supports experiential learning

100% of the employers agreed to it and 71 % strongly agree that syllabus supports experiential learning.




6. Skill development is given due importance in the syllabus

All the employers are of the opinion that skill development is given due importance in the syllabus.




6. The objectives are clear and specific
