No. of Responses Received : 127

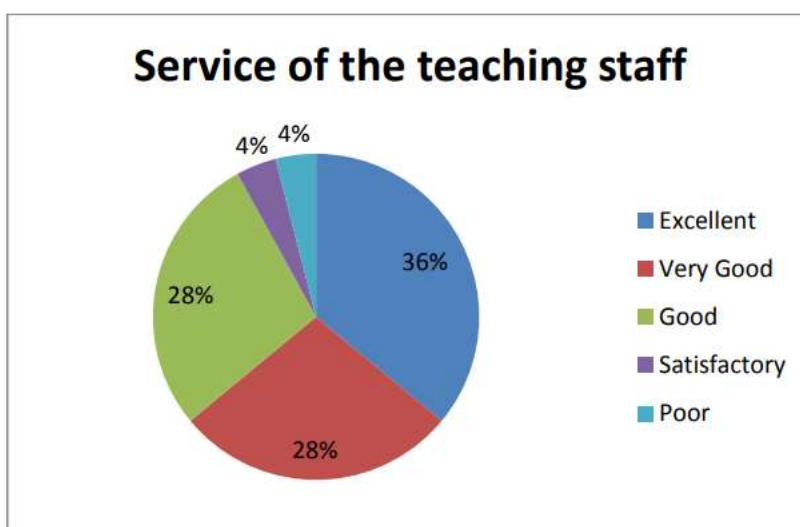
Nature of Questionnaire:

The sample questionnaire is attached as Annexure I. The students were asked to mark their opinion on a 4-point scale. Feedback was collected on Curriculum, Infrastructure, Individual teachers and Effectiveness of Online Teaching. Suggestions on curriculum was asked for. Any other general suggestions were also sought.

Observations and Analysis:

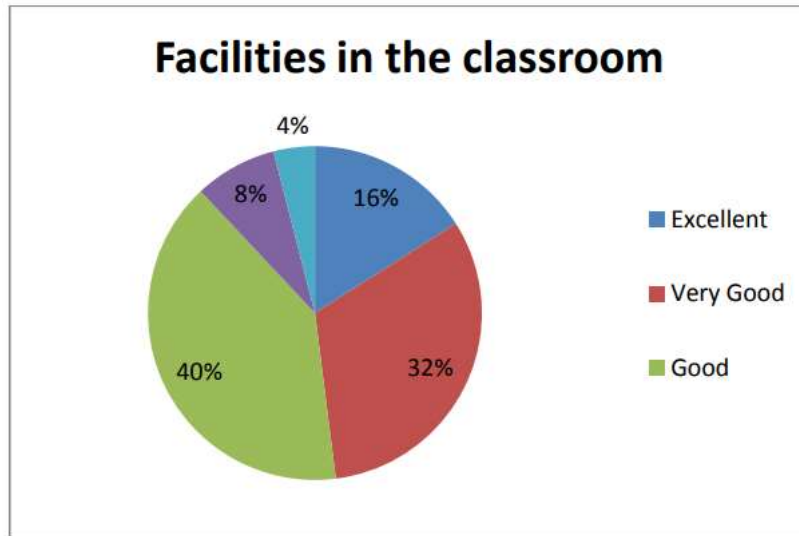
1. Service of the teaching staff

The feedback of the students with regard to service of the teaching staff was analysed. 92% of the students who responded have good opinion about the teachers. Of which 36% have excellent opinion and 28% very good opinion.



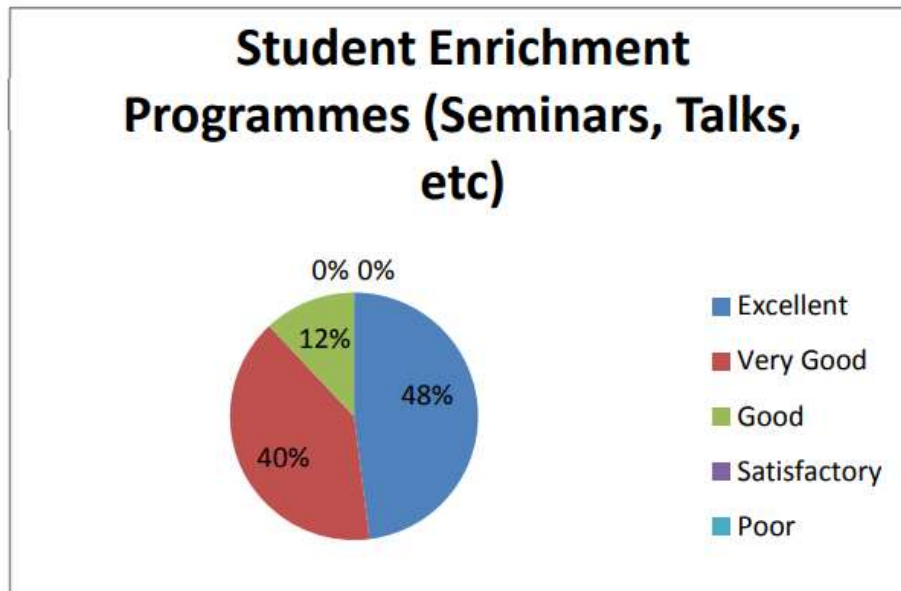
2. Facilities in the classroom

88% of the students are satisfied with the facilities in the classroom. 16% has excellent opinion and 32% has good opinion about it.



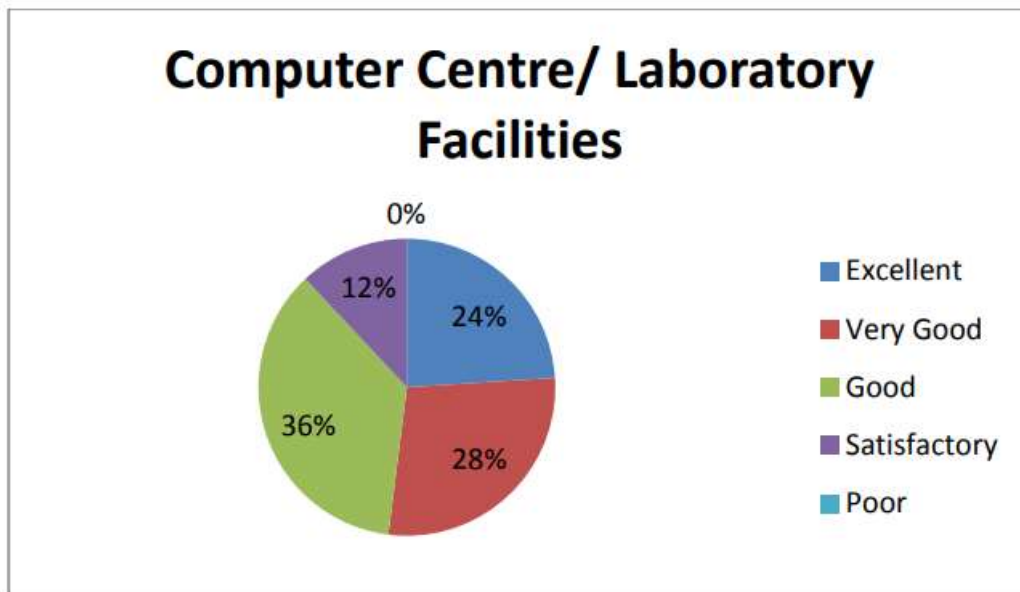
3. Student enrichment programmes

All the students are satisfied with the student enrichment programmes organised in the college. Every respondent has good opinion reading the same.



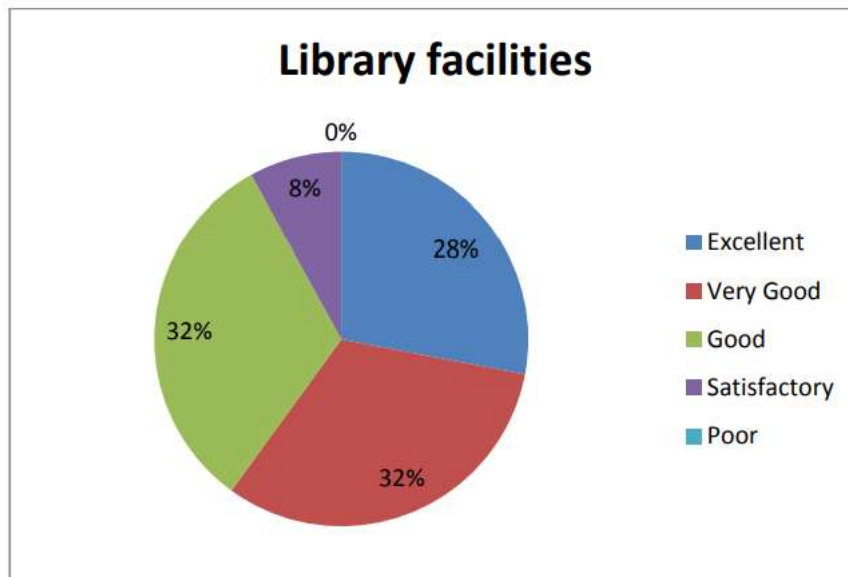
4. Computer Centre / Laboratory Facilities

With regard to the computer centre and laboratory facilities of the college, 88% of the students have good opinion about it while 12% consider it to be satisfactory.



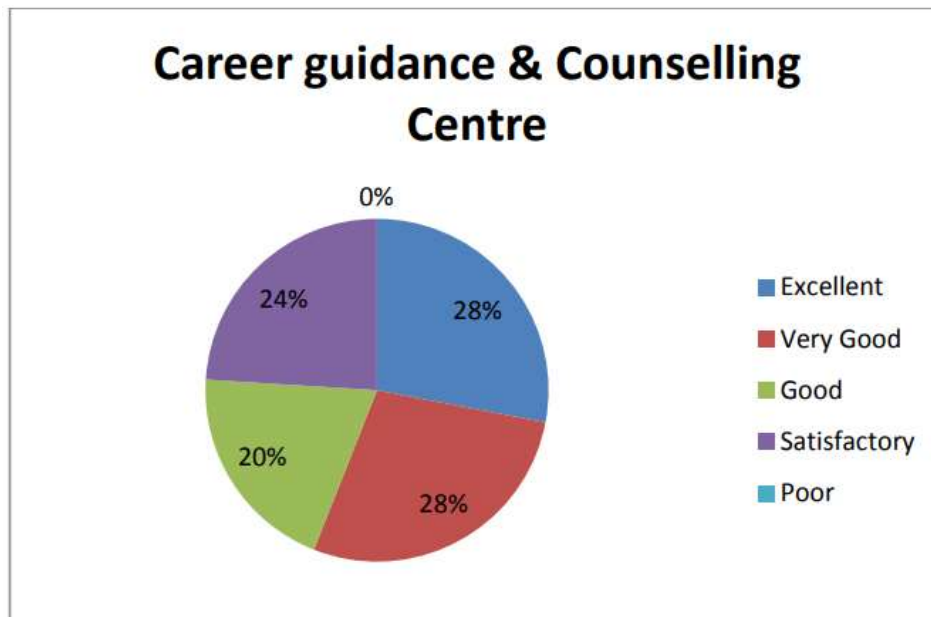
5. Library facilities

All the students are satisfied with the library facility offered by the college. Of which 50% of the students have very good opinion about it and 8% consider it to be satisfactory.



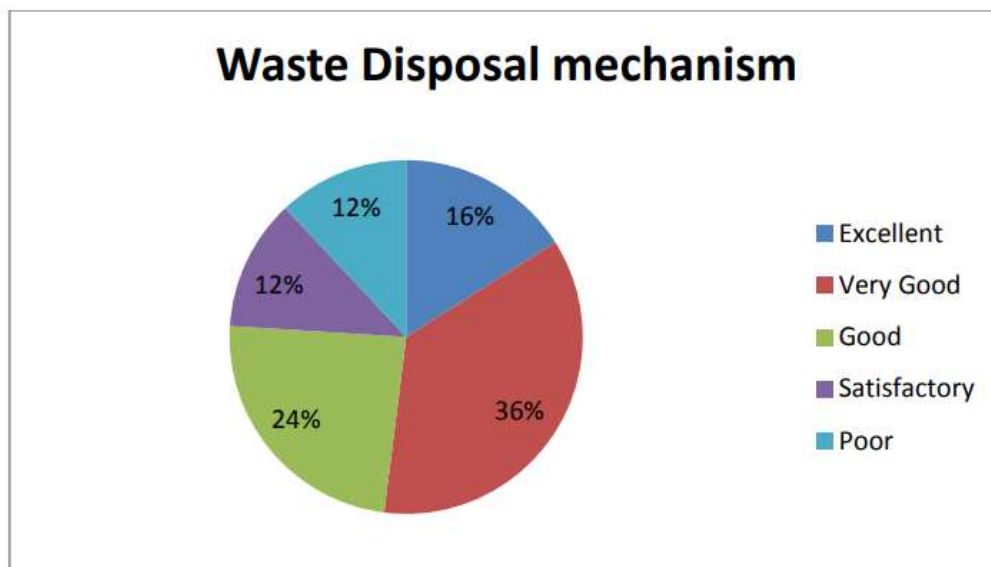
6. Career guidance and counselling centre

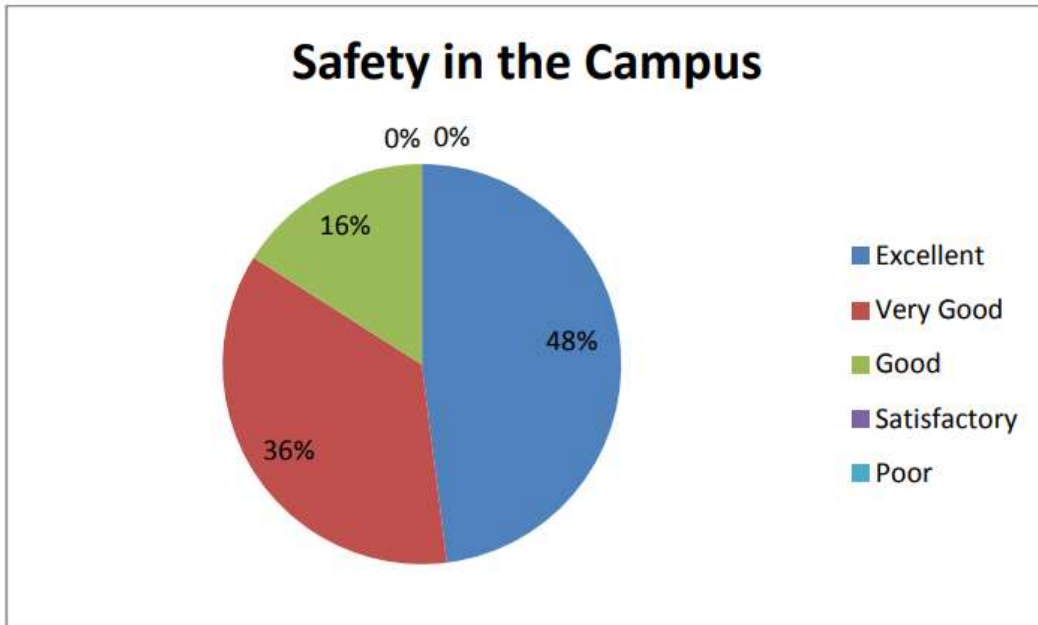
7. Waste disposal mechanism

76% of the students consider the waste disposal mechanism of the institution to be good. Of this 52% of them consider it be very good. 12% however believes that it should be improved.



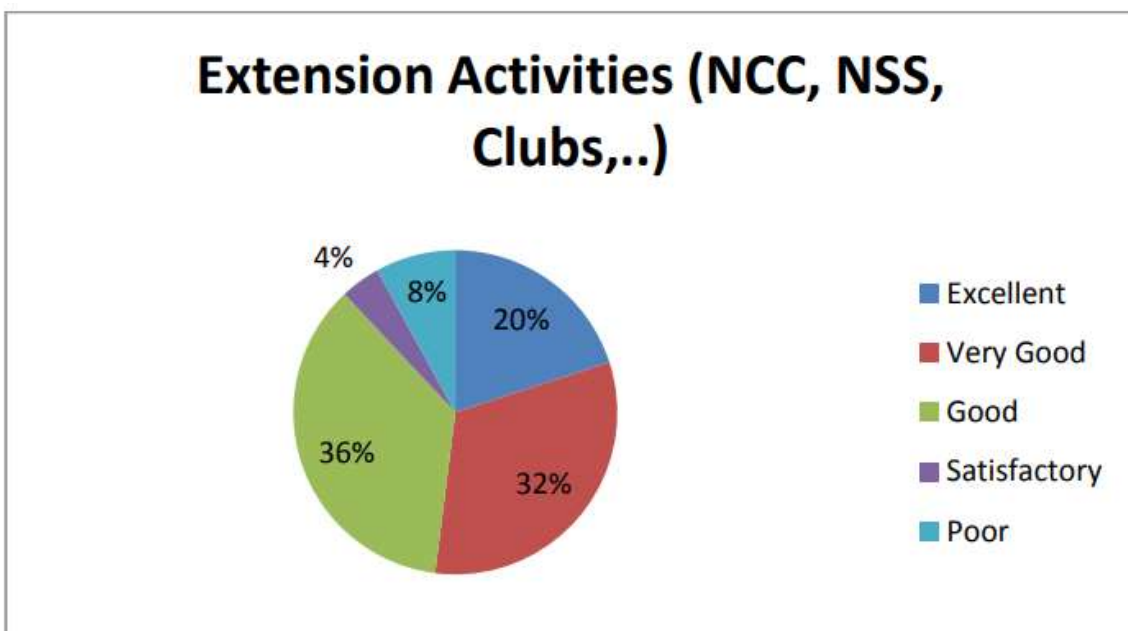
8. Safety in the campus

The feedback of the students with regard to safety in the campus was analysed. All the students have good opinion about it. 48% of the students have excellent opinion in this respect.



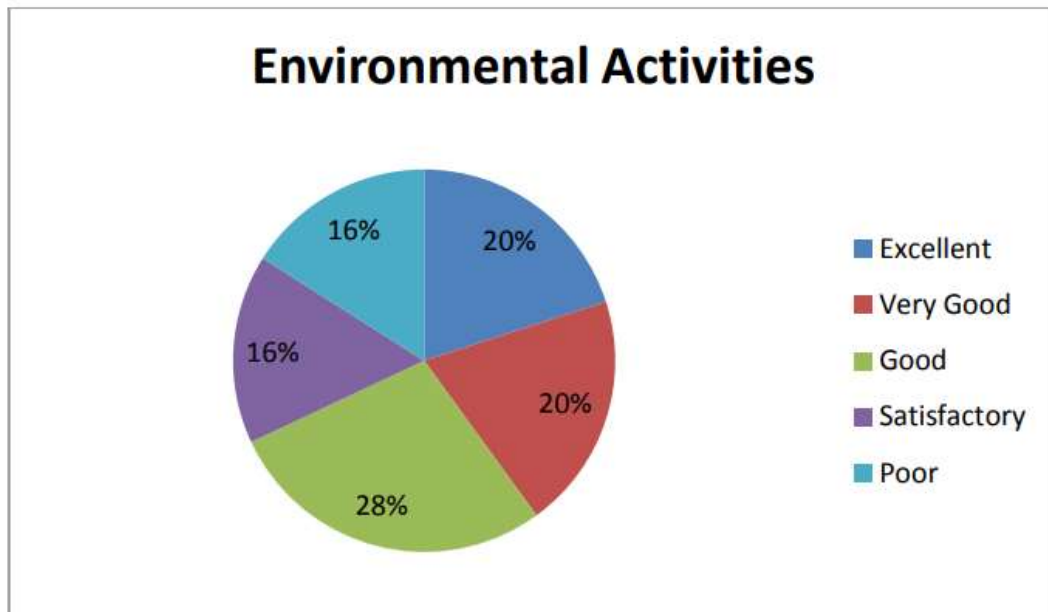
9. Extension Activities

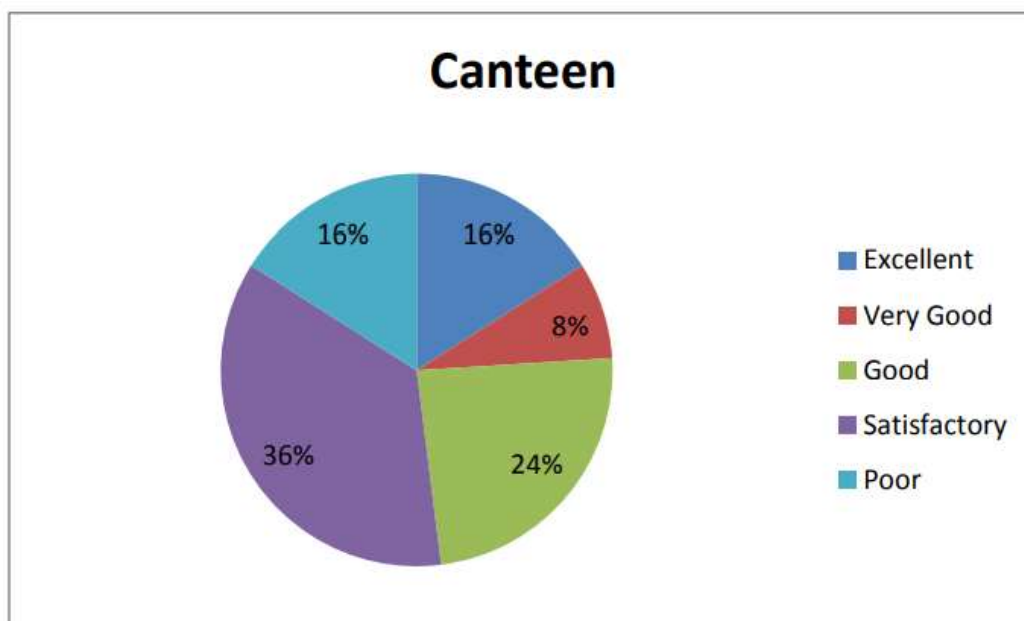
10. Environmental Activities

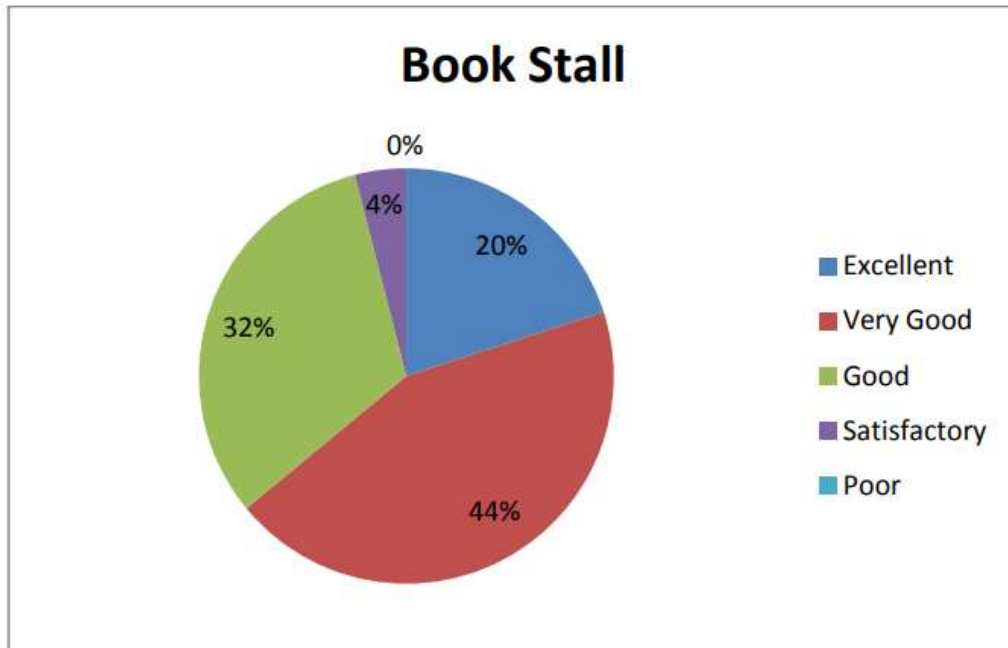
11. Canteen

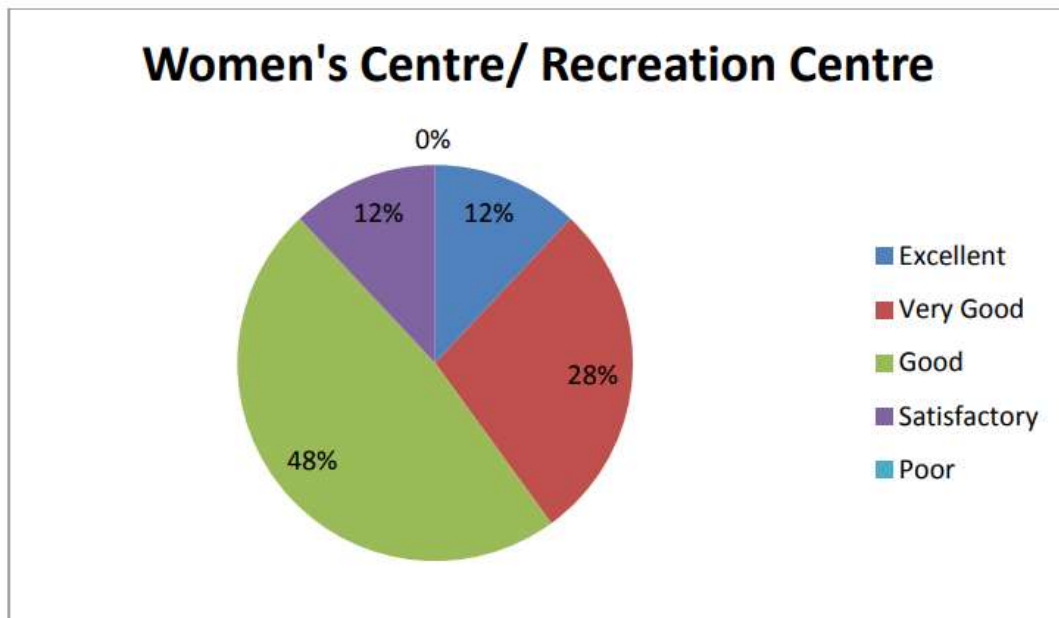
12. Book Stall

The college has a bookstall facility in the campus. All the students are satisfied with the book stall facility offered. 64% of them consider it to be very good.



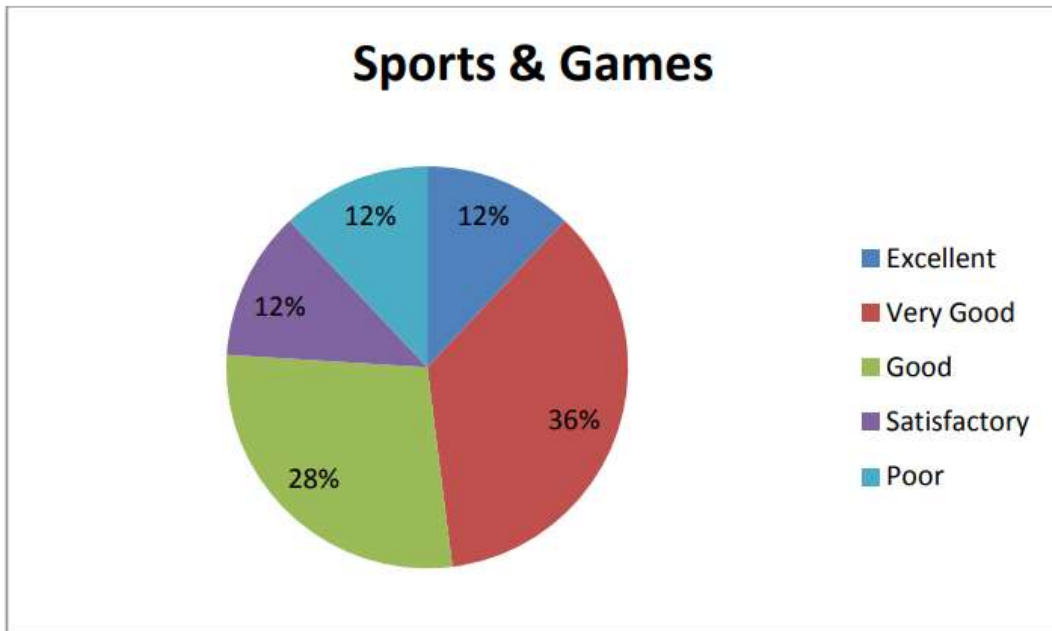
13. Women's Centre / Recreation Centre

The institution has a Women's centre for girl students. All the girl students are satisfied with this facility. Of this 88% of them consider it to be good.



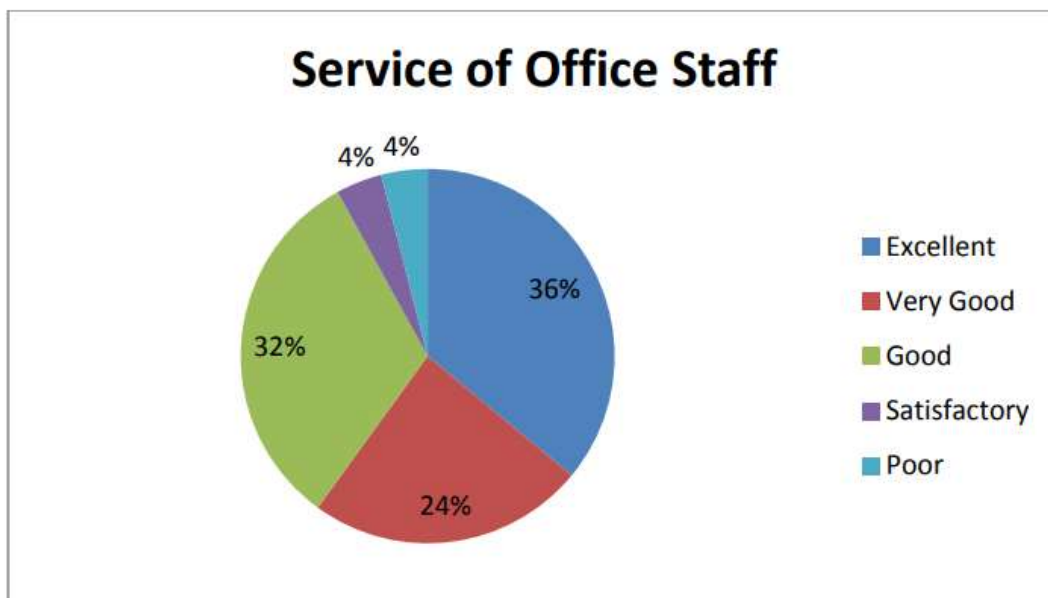
14. Sports and Games

On analysis of the feedback with regard to office staff, 92% of the students consider it to be good. Of this 60% of them believe that they receive very good service in the college office.



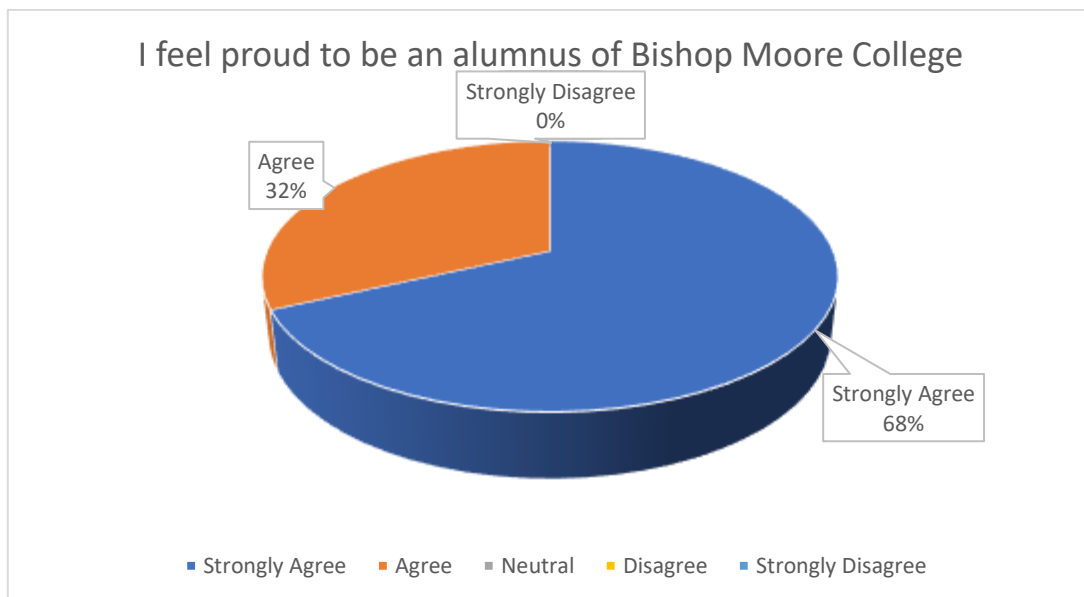
Important Findings:

3. More attention required in environmental protection activities and sensitising students towards the initiatives existing in college
4. Laboratory facilities need improvement.

ALUMNI

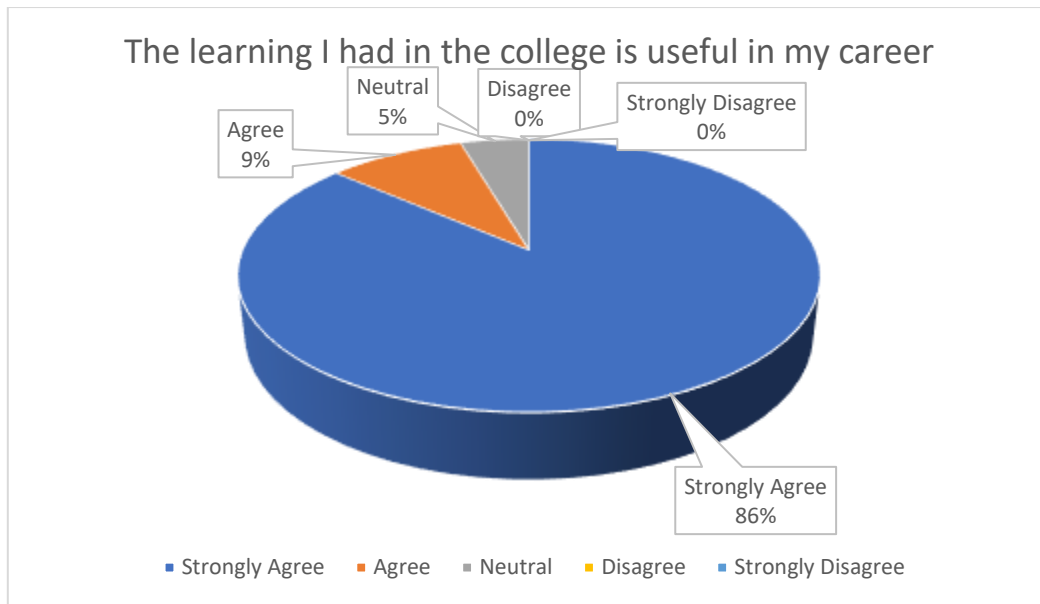
1. Whether proud to be an alumnus of Bishop Moore College

All the alumni who responded are of the opinion that they are proud to be a part of the college. Of this 68% of them strongly agree to this statement and 32% agrees.



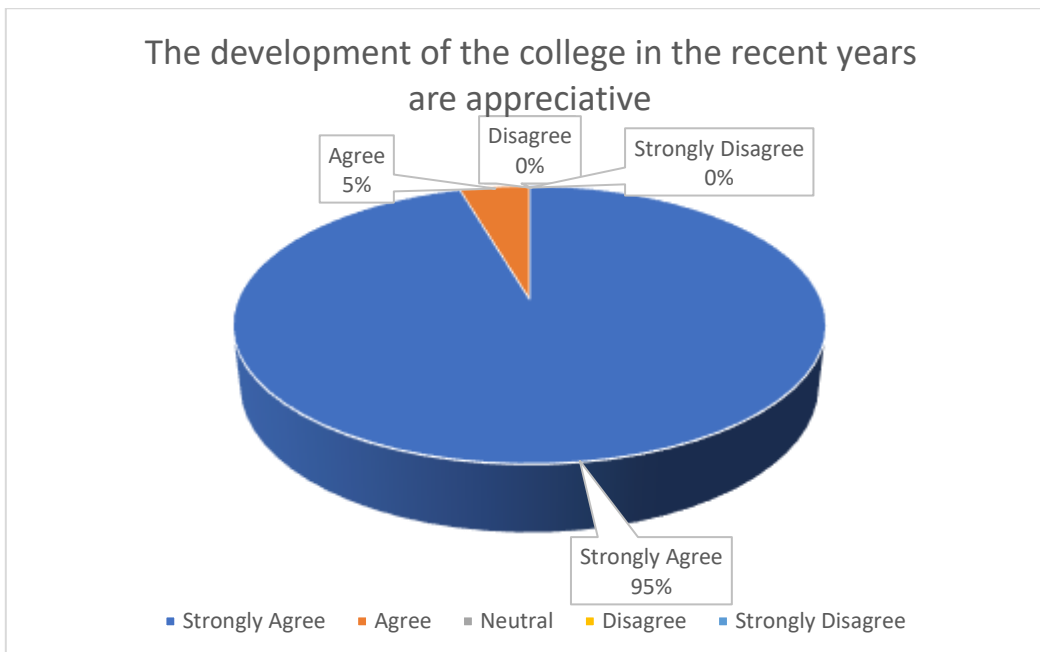
2. Learning received from college is useful in career

95% of the alumni believe that the learning they received from the college has been useful in their career. 5% of them holds a neutral viewpoint to it. None of them disagrees the statement.



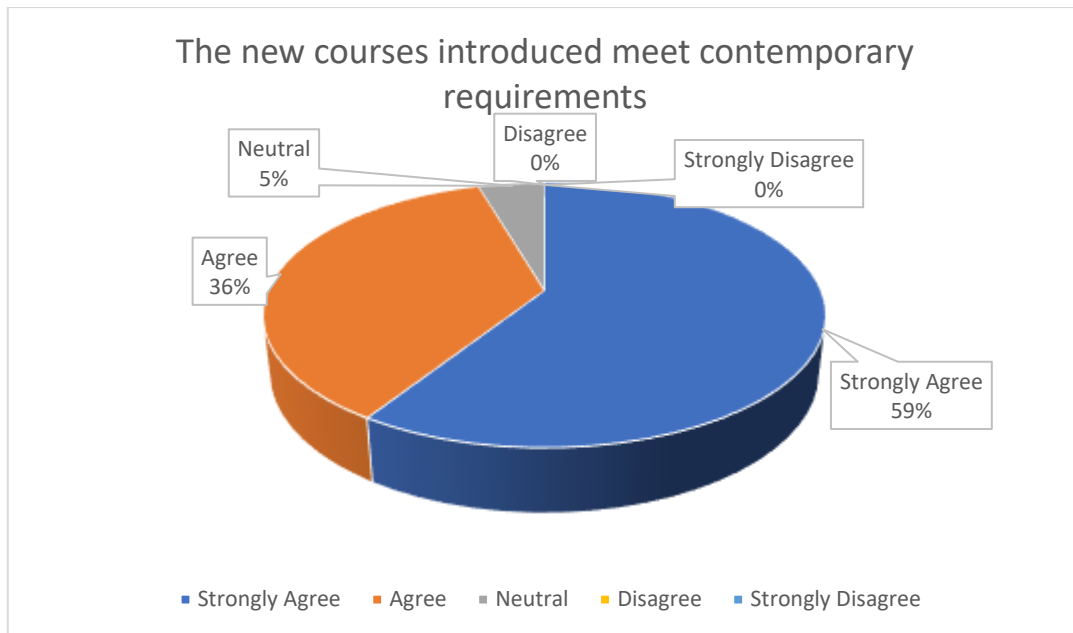
3. Development of the college in recent years is appreciative

All the alumni respondents believe that the development of the college in the recent years is appreciative. 95% of them strongly appreciates this development.



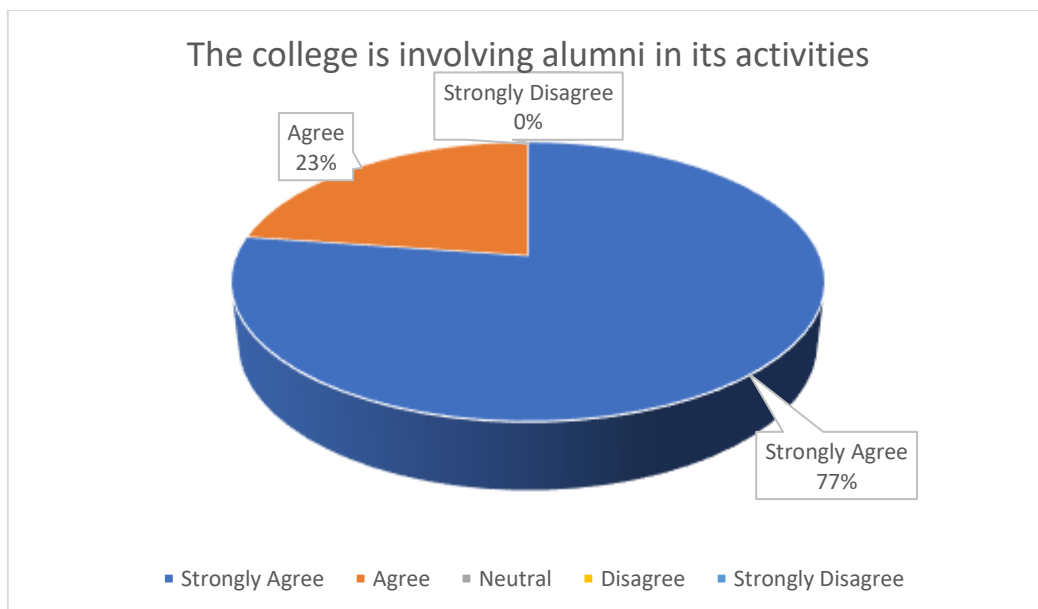
4. New courses introduced meet the contemporary requirements

95% of the alumni who responded are of the viewpoint that the new courses offered are in line with the contemporary requirements, although 5% of them holds a neutral view towards it.



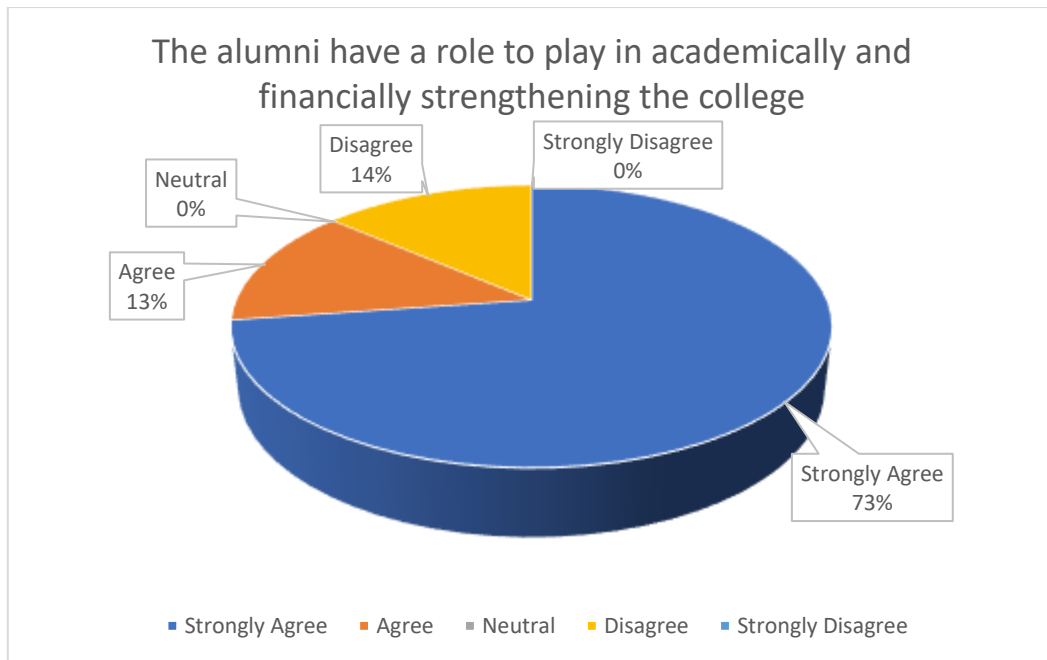
5. College involves alumni in its activities

All the alumni are satisfied with the way the college involves them in its activities. 77% of them strongly agrees to the statement and 23% agrees to it.



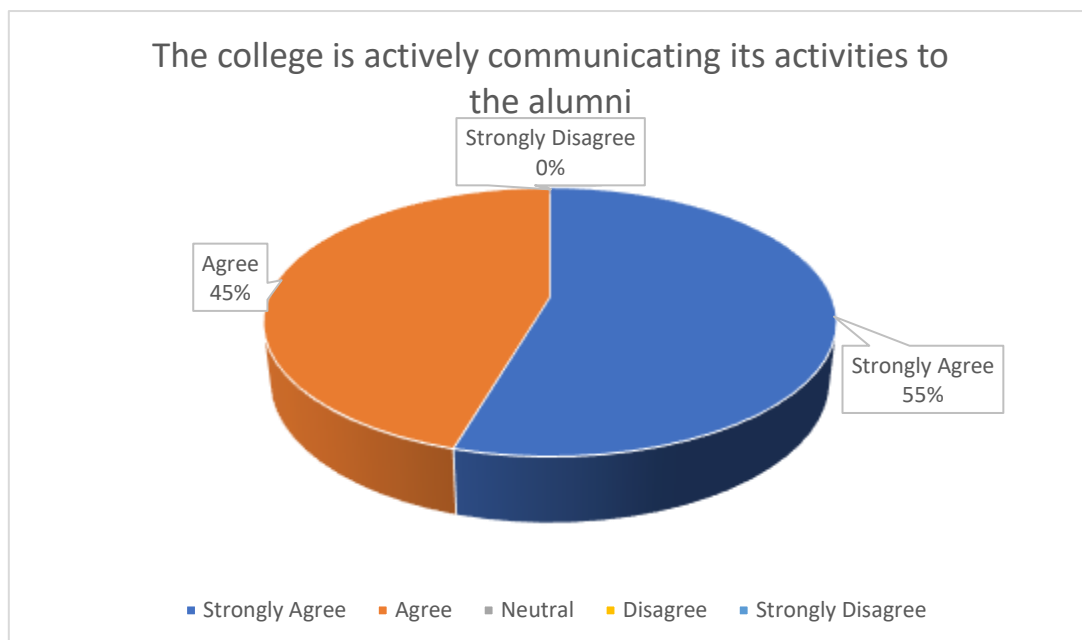
6. Alumni has a role in strengthening the college academically and financially

All the alumni respondents are aware of the activities taking place in the college. 55% of them strongly agree to it and 45% agree to it.



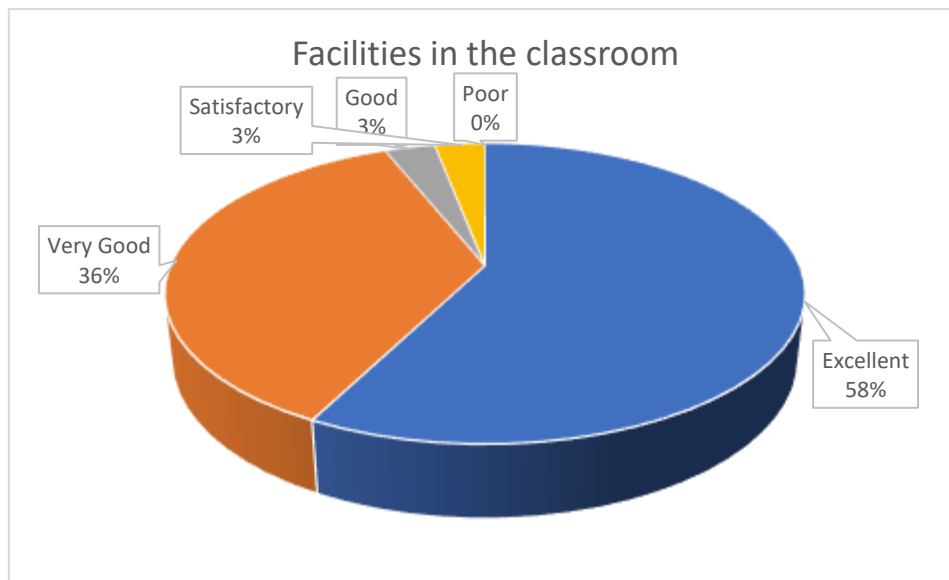
Important Findings:

FACULTY

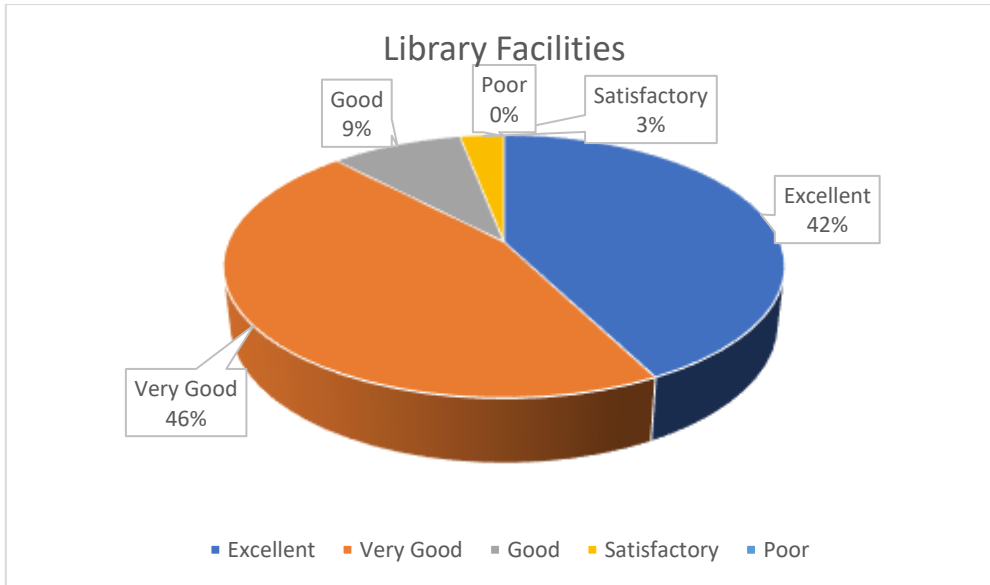
1. Facilities in the classroom

The feedback of the faculties with regard to facilities in the classroom was analysed. 94% of the faculties consider it to be very good. 3% as good and 3% satisfactory. None of them considers it to be poor.



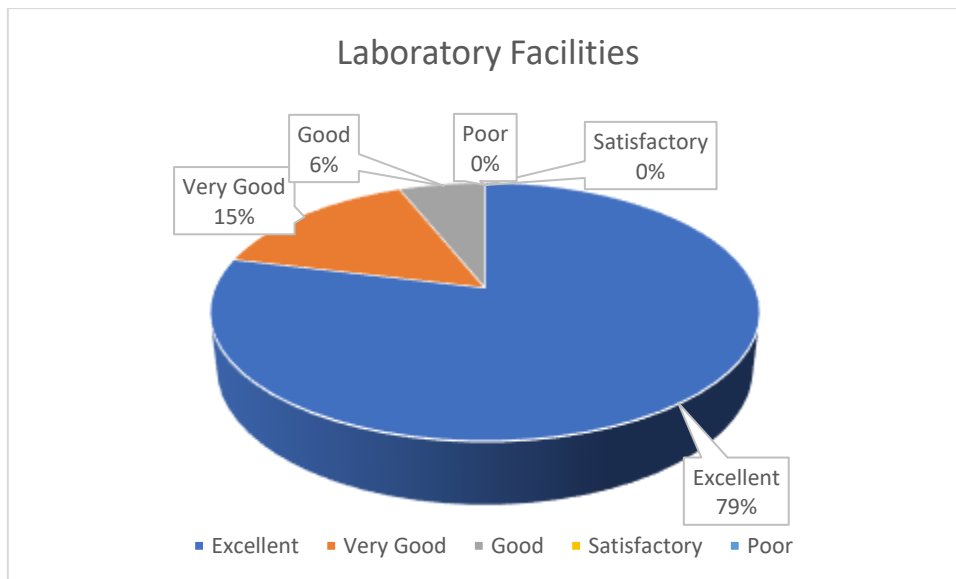
2. Library facilities

88% of the faculties who responded are pleased with the library in the college. 9% of them consider it to be good and 3% satisfactory.



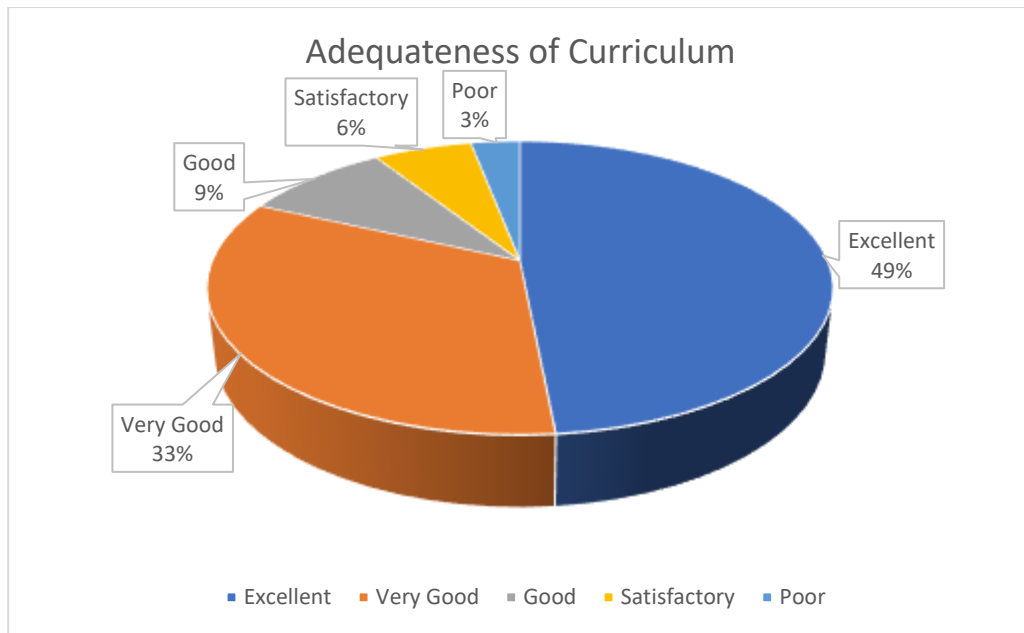
3. Laboratory facilities

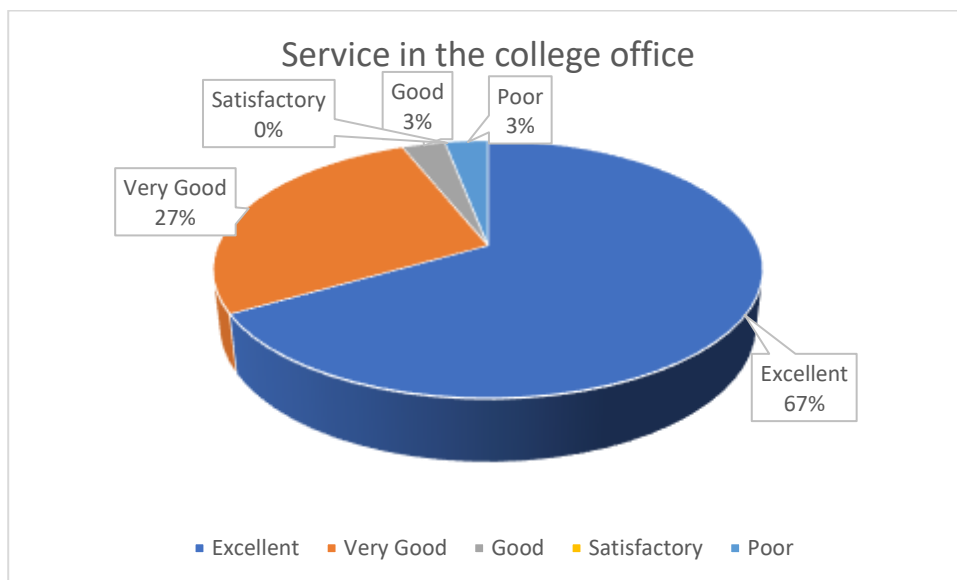
4. Adequateness of curriculum

91% of the teachers considers the curriculum followed in the institution to be good. However, 6% consider it to be satisfactory and 3% believes it needs an amendment.



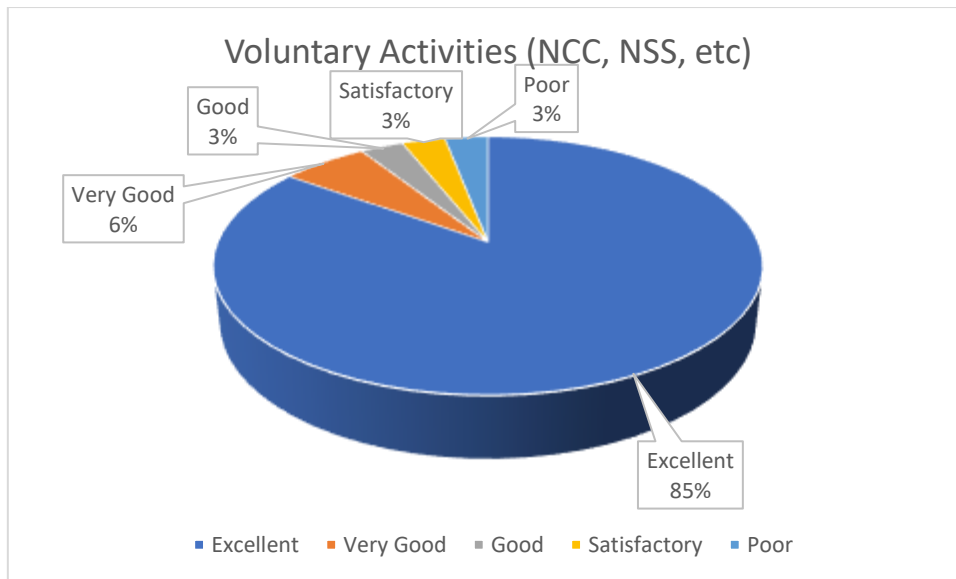
5. Service in the college office

97% of the faculties have good opinion about the college office. Of this 94% consider the office provides meticulous and applaudable service in the institution.



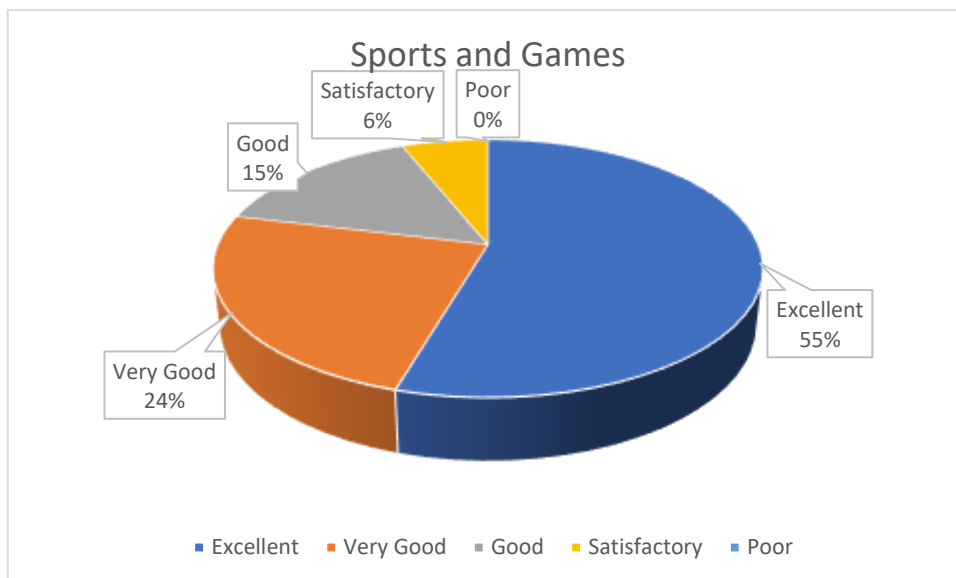
6. Voluntary Activities

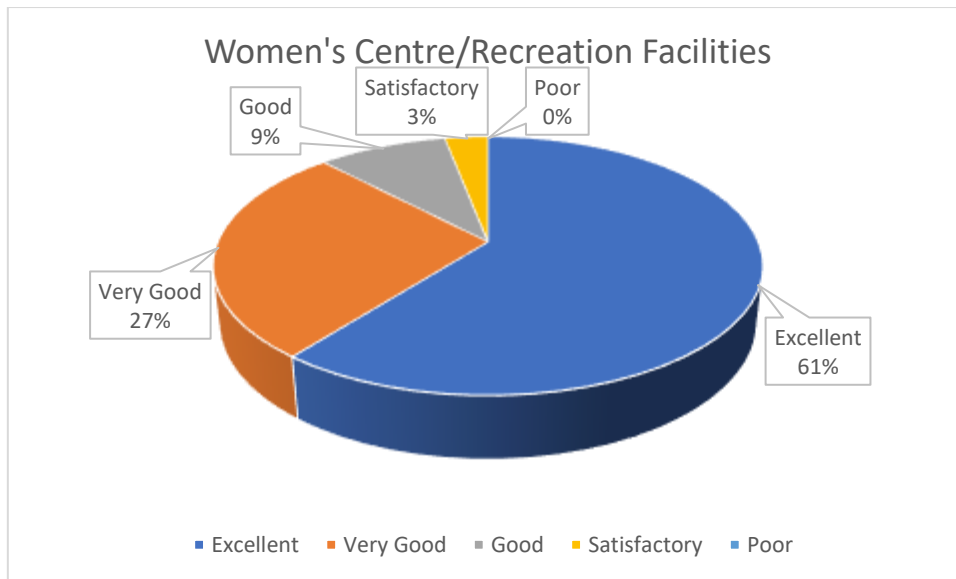
7. Sports and games

94% of the faculties have good opinion about the sports and games activities in the college. 6% of them consider it to be satisfactory. None of them has poor opinion in this respect.



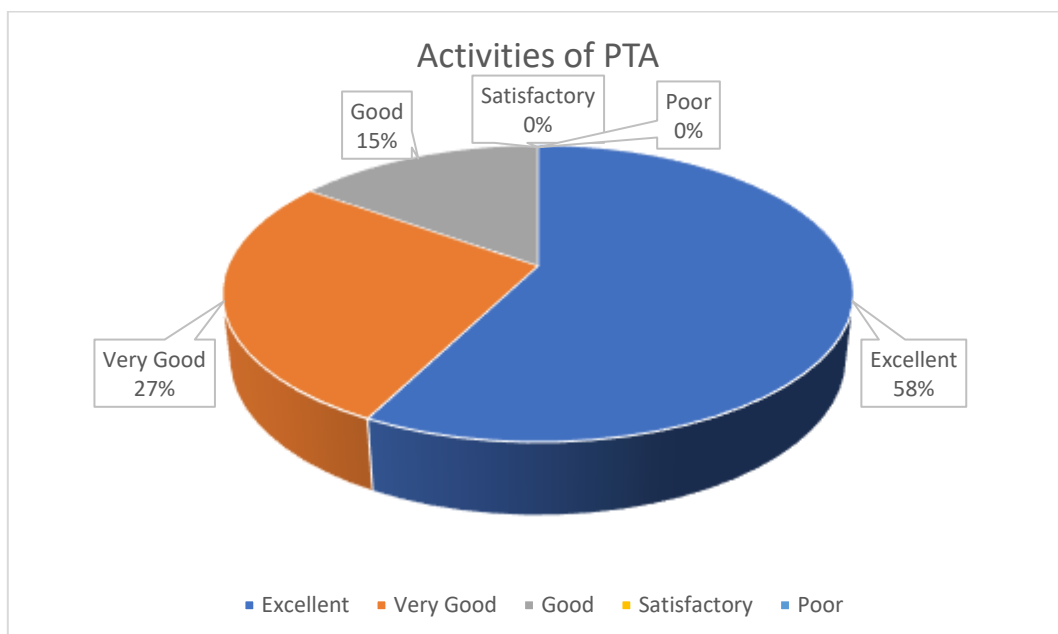
8. Women’s Centre / Recreation facilities

97% of the teachers have positive outlook towards women’s centre and recreation facilities in the college. They are satisfied about these amenities.



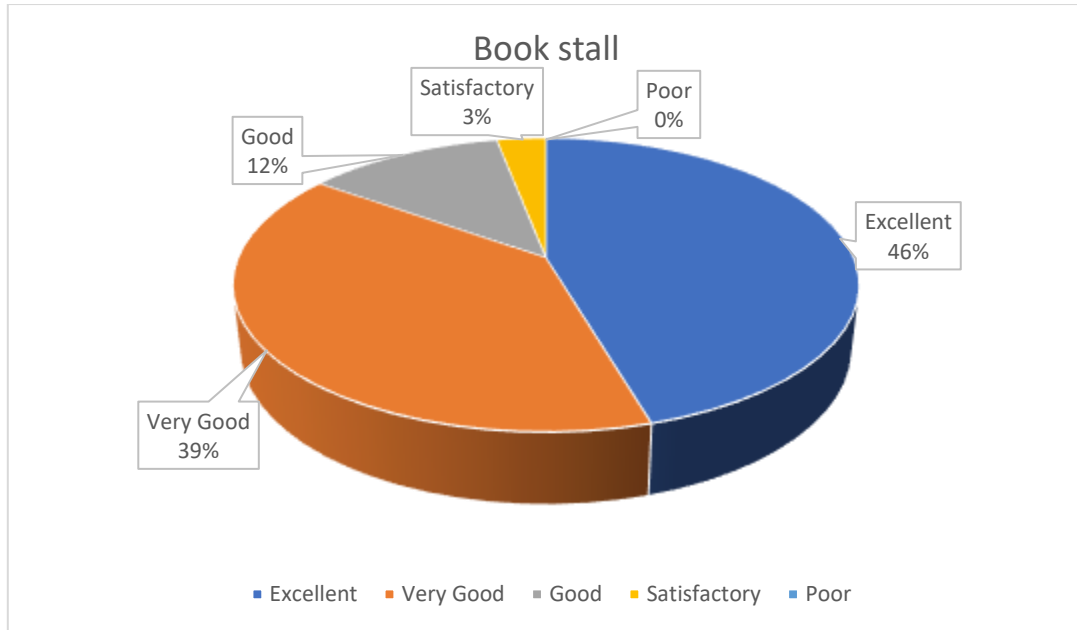
9. Activities of PTA

85% of the faculties who responded consider the activities of the PTA to be very good and 15% as good. All of them believes it to being conducted well.



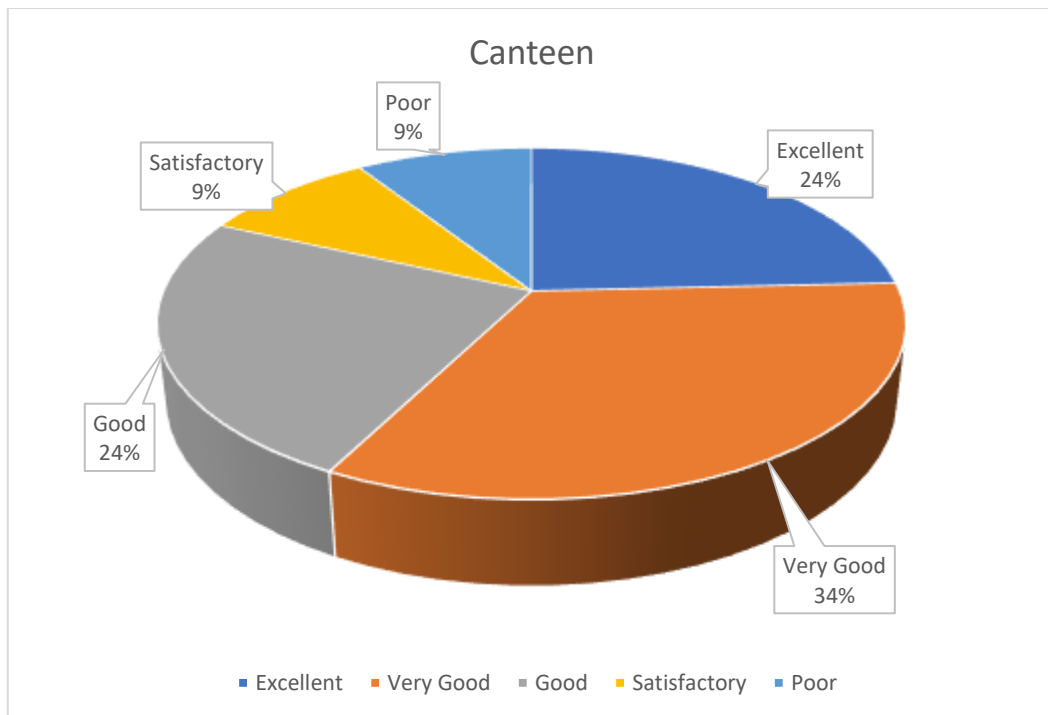
10. Book stall

The college has book stall facility in the campus. All the students and faculties make use of this facility. 97% of the faculties have good opinion about the same. 3% consider it to be satisfactory.



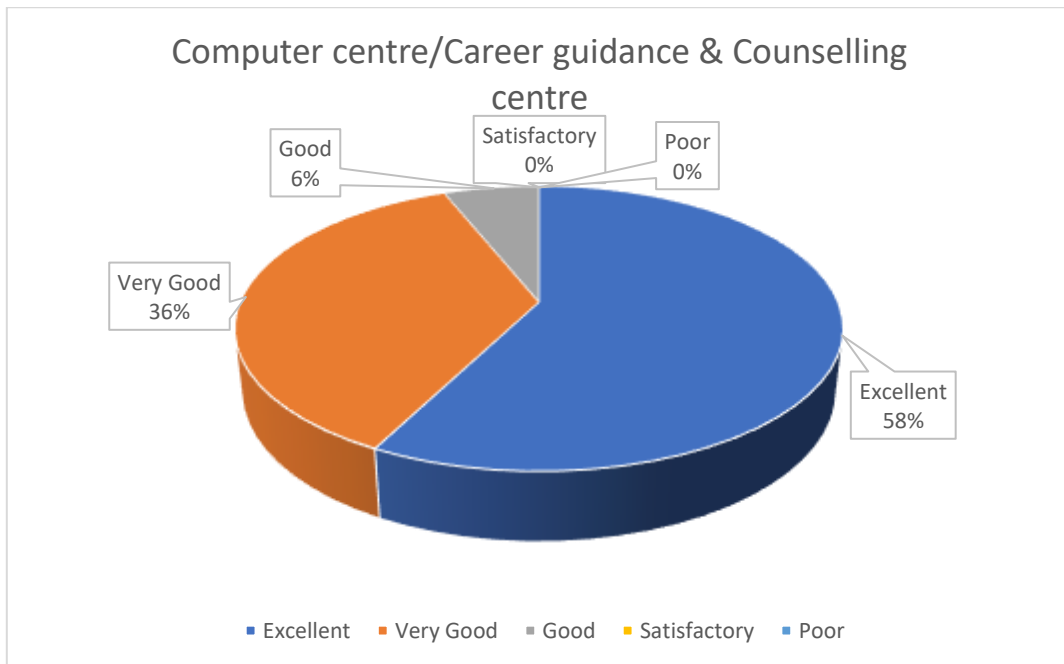
11. Canteen

82% of the faculties have good opinion about the canteen facility in the campus. However, 9% of them requires that it should be improved and another 9% consider it to be just satisfactory.



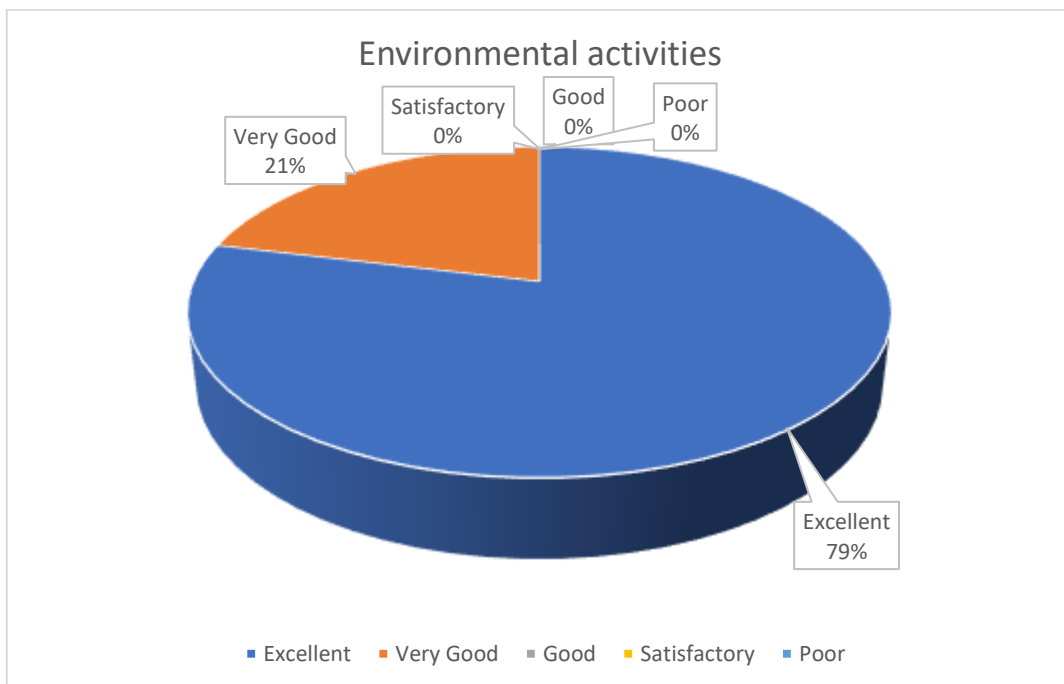
12. Computer Centre/ Career Guidance & Counselling Centre

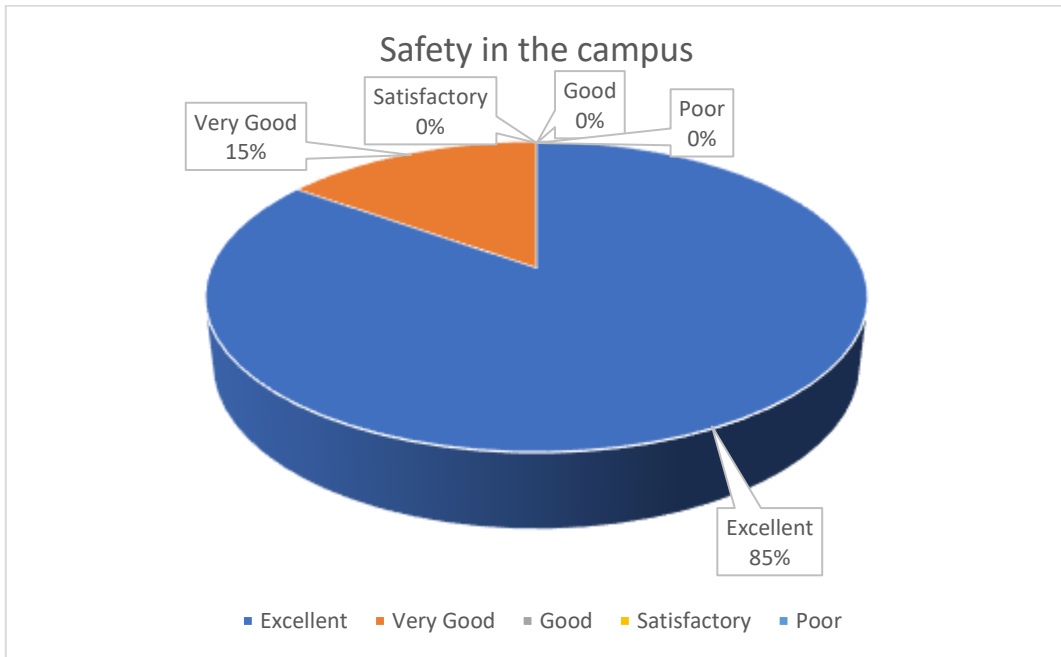
13. Environmental activities

The college believes in undertaking environment friendly activities. All the faculties have a positive viewpoint in this respect.



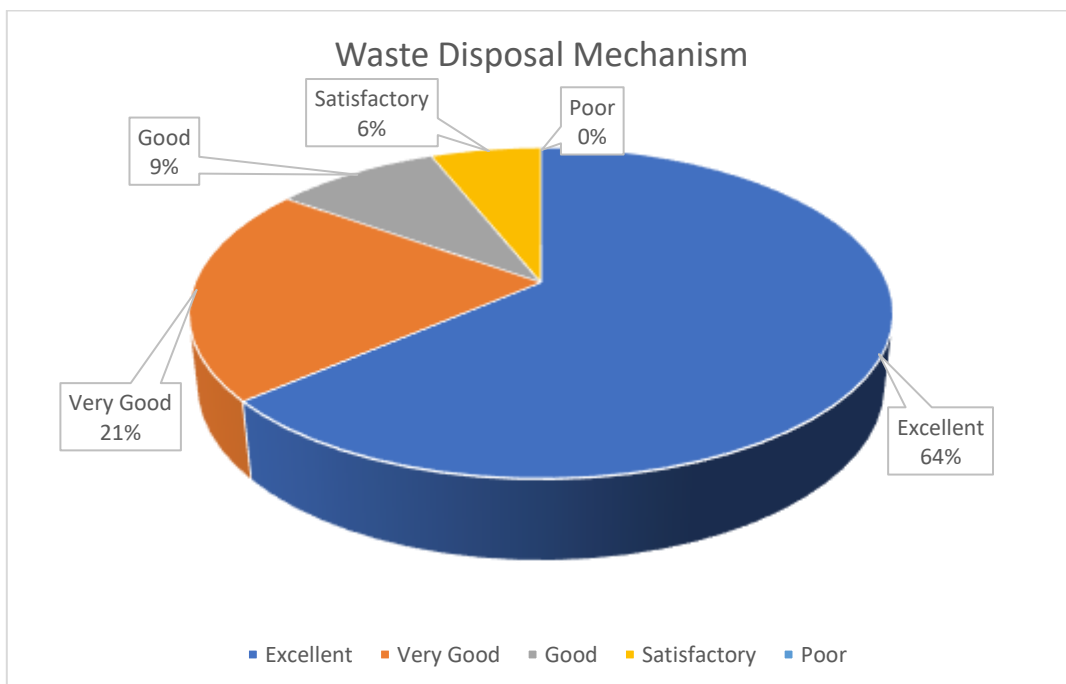
14. Safety in the campus

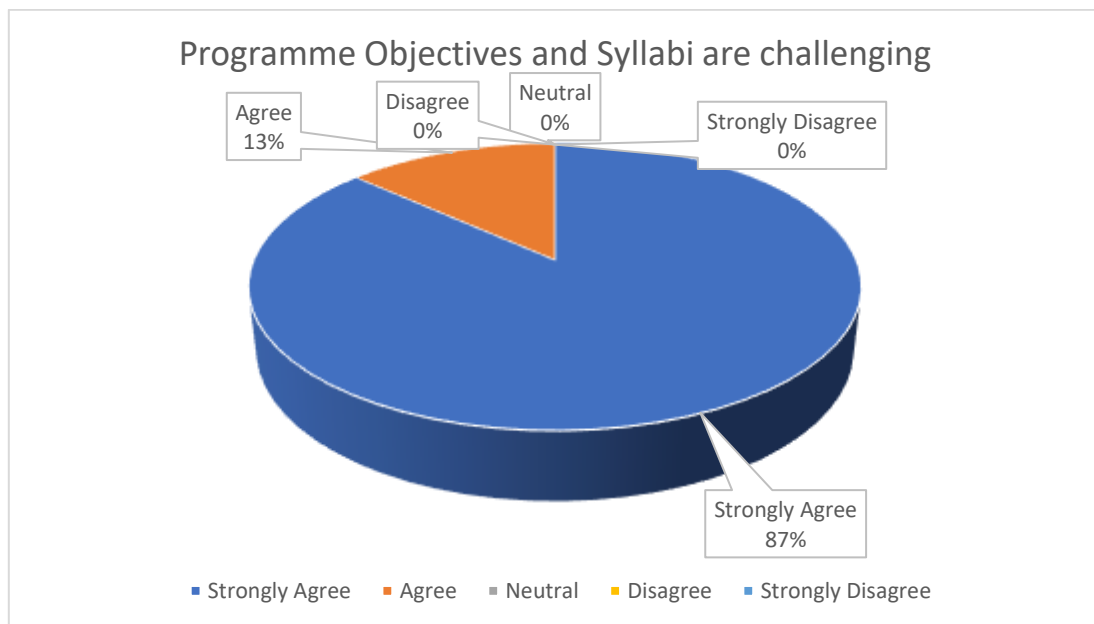
Important Findings:

EMPLOYER

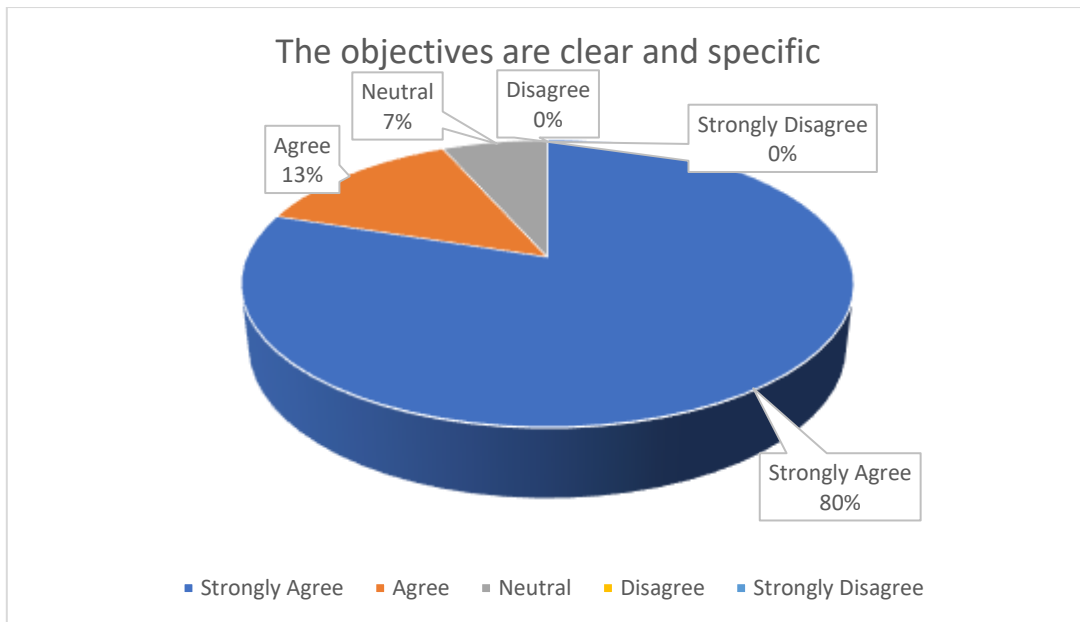
1. Programme objectives and syllabi are challenging

All the employers who responded consider the programme objectives and syllabi to be challenging. 87% of them strongly agree to it and 13% agrees.



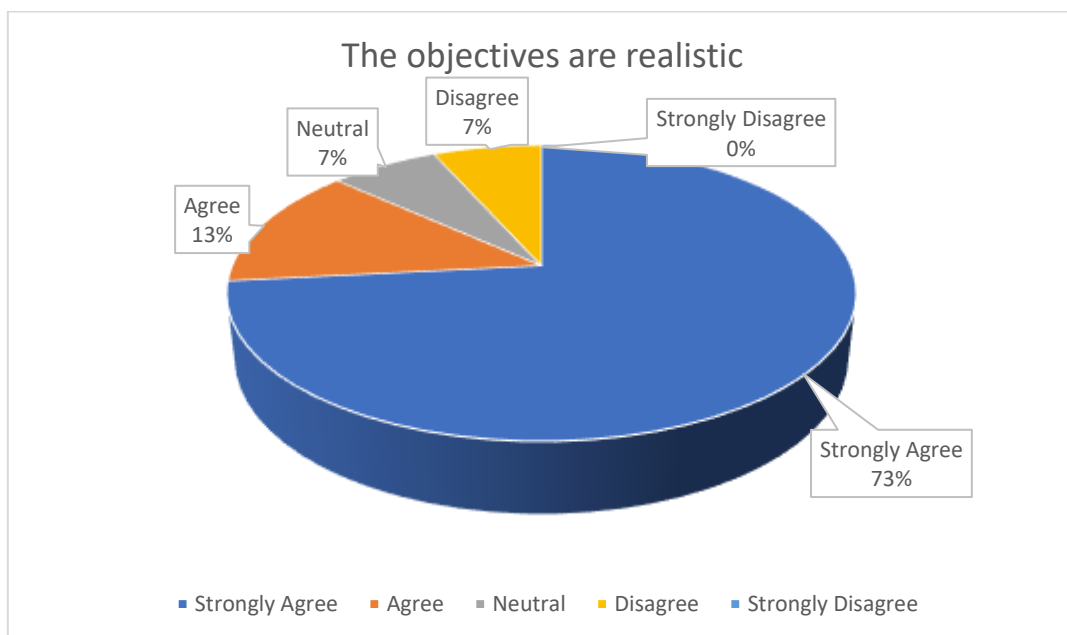
2. Objectives are clear and specific

93% of the employers who responded consider the programme and course objectives to be clear and specific. 7% however has maintained a neutral view towards it.



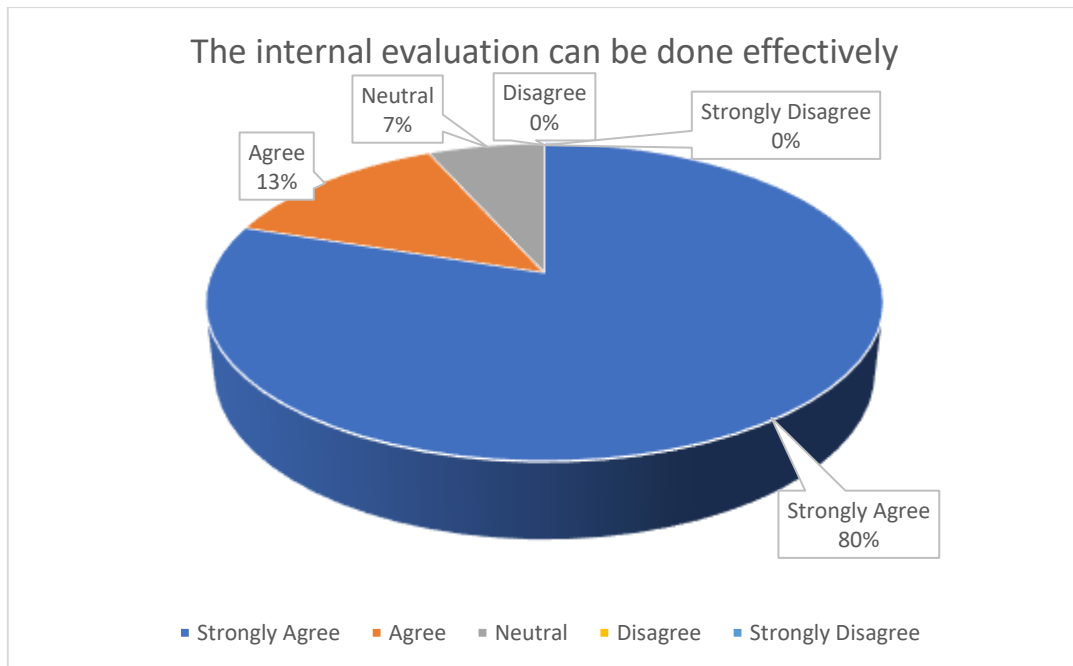
3. Objectives are realistic

86% of the employers believes the objectives of the programmes and courses to be realistic. 7% however, disagrees to this and another 7% do not have an opinion on it.



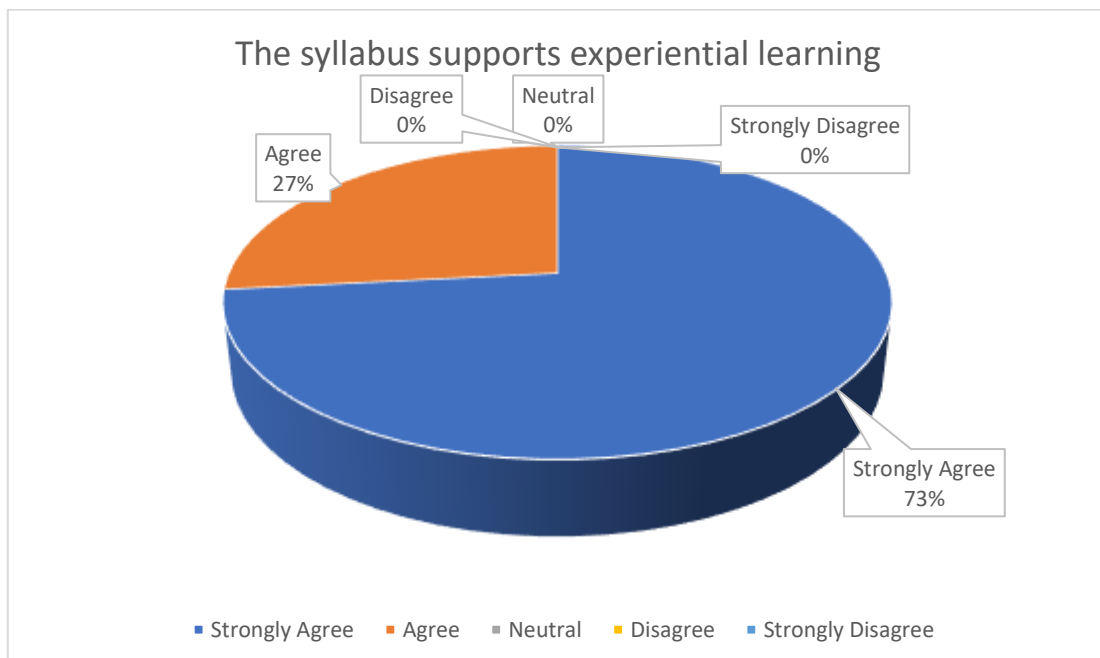
4. Internal Evaluation is done effectively

93% of the respondents believes the internal evaluation as being done effectively. 80% of them strongly agrees to it. However, 7% of them has a neutral stand point regarding it.



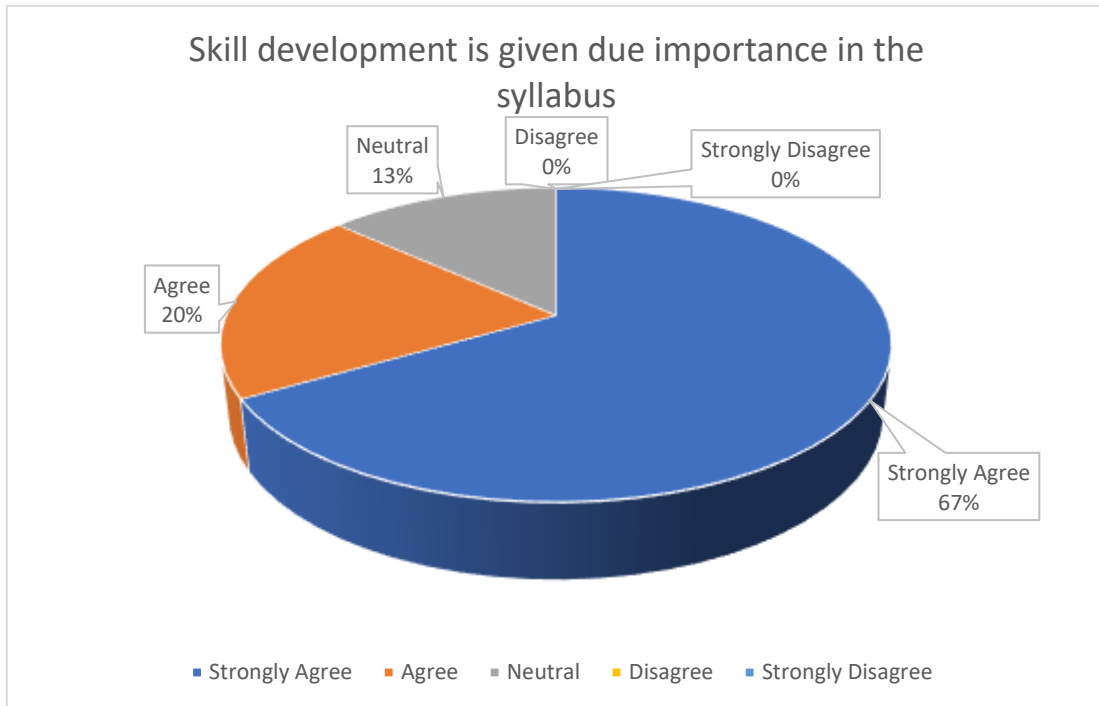
5. Syllabus supports experiential learning

All the employers are of the opinion that the syllabus followed by the institution supports experiential learning. Of this 73% of them strongly supports the statement and 27% of them agrees to it.



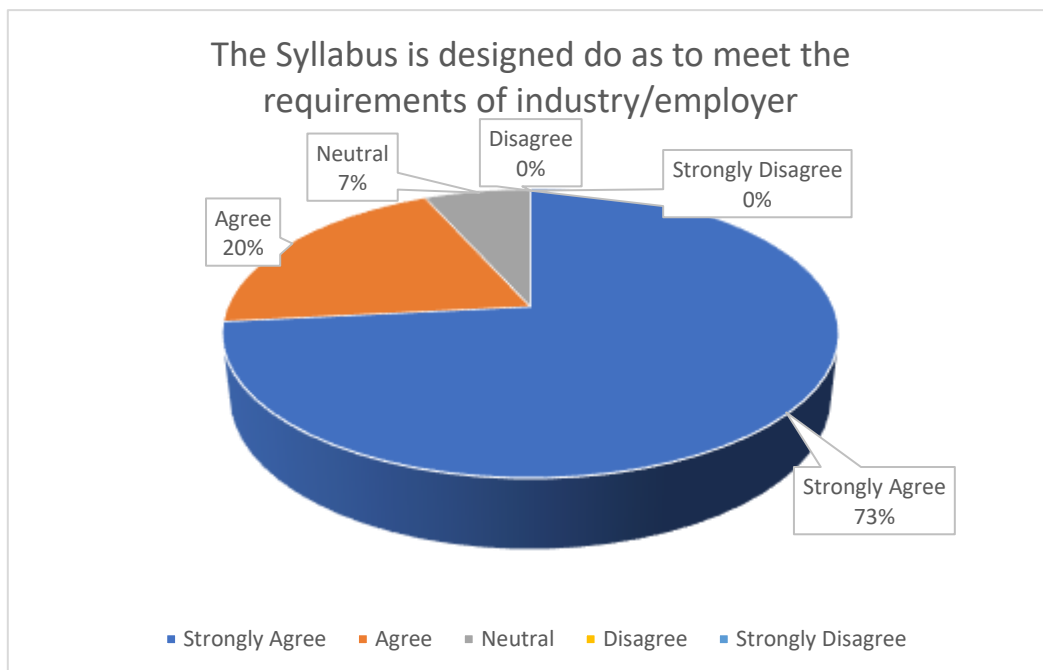
6. Skill development is given due importance in the syllabus

87% of the employers who responded believe that skill development is given due importance in the syllabus. 13% however, do not have an opinion regarding it.



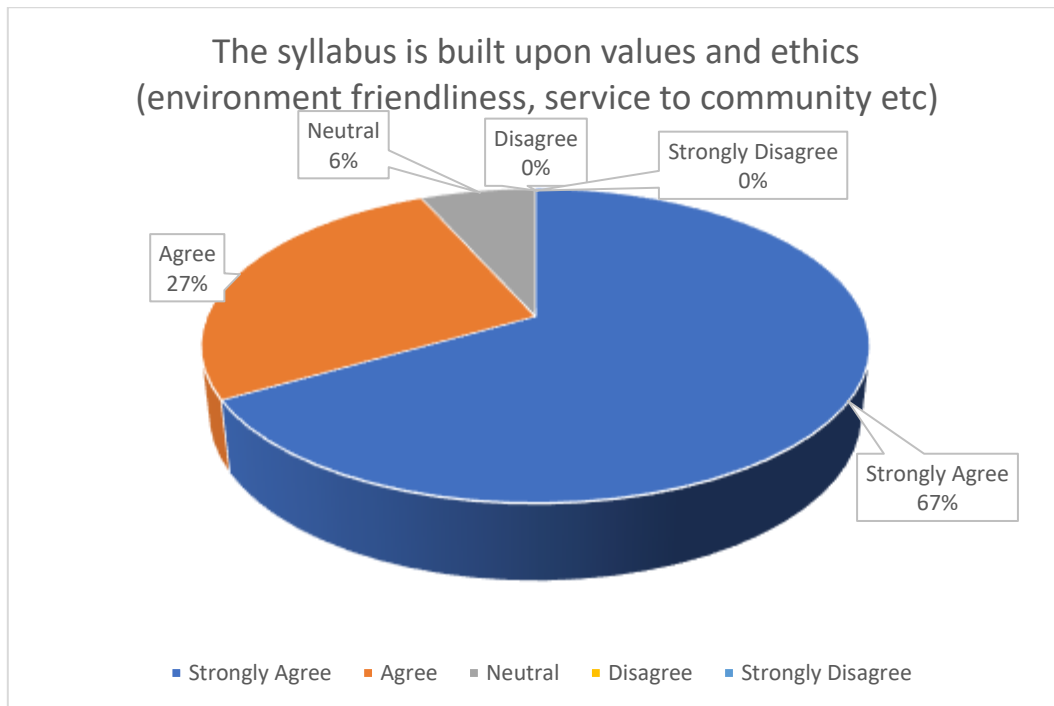
7. Syllabus meets the requirements of the industry and employers
