

Nature of Questionnaire:

The sample questionnaire is attached as Annexure I. The students were asked to mark their opinion on a 5-point scale. Feedback was collected on Curriculum, Infrastructure, Individual teachers and Effectiveness of Online Teaching. Suggestions on curriculum was asked for. Any other general suggestions were also sought.

Methodology Used in Analysis:

Likert scoring methodology was adopted. For each question on the questionnaire, the total number of responses for each sentiment level was found and respective weighted score was calculated. The totals received were divided by the total number of respondents:




Observations and Analysis:

1. Syllabus of the course studied

92.5% of the students who responded are of the opinion that the syllabus of their course if adequate. Of which 34% of them consider it as challenging. Majority of the students are pleased with the syllabus they are learning.




2. Completion of syllabus in class


How much of the syllabus was taught in the class




The internal examination system in the college is 159 responses

93% of the students are satisfied with the student teacher relationship in the college. Of which 74.8% of the students have good opinion regarding the same.


How do you rate the student-teacher relationship in the whole college 159 responses

How do you rate the student-teacher relationship in your Department 159 responses




7. College Office Facilities

How do you find the college office facilities?



How do you find the laboratory facilities for the course? 159 responses




9. Attitude of teachers to extra-curricular activities.




10. Computer facilities in the college

76.7% of the students have good opinion regarding the computer facility in the college and 17.6% consider it to be satisfactory.


How do you rate the computer facilities in the college




12. Sports facilities in the college




13. Safety in the campus




14. Environment Friendliness of the Campus





15. How proudly will you talk about the college?


Important Findings:

- 1. Feedback on Curriculum: Majority of the students commented that the syllabus is adequate of which marked the syllabus to be challenging. Only very few students commented that the syllabus is inadequate or dull
- 2. Library Facilities: Majority commented that the library facilities are excellent.
- 3. Internal Examination System: Majority of the students mentioned that the internal examination system is adequate.
- 4. The environment friendliness and safety in campus are marked exemplary.
- 5. The overall attitude of the students towards the college is highly positive.
- 6. Canteen Facilities need urgent upgradation
- 7. Sports and Ladies Hostel Facilities also require improvement.


I. CURRICULUM DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT


2. The curriculum is updated from time to time

91% of the respondents are satisfied with the timely amendment of the curriculum by the university. None of them are dissatisfied with it.




3. Due weightage for employability in the curriculum


4. Freedom to contribute ideas for curriculum design and development

5. Representation from business and industry in PG Board for improving courses


45% of the respondents are expressed the positive impacts of having representation from business and industry in PG Board of studies. 9% however disagrees to it.



II. TEACHING-LEARNING AND RESEARCH


1. The admission process adopted by the university is effective

The feedback regarding the effectiveness of the admission process of the university was analysed. 100% of the faculties are satisfied with the university admission process.




2. The University is able to attract meritorious students


3. Student learning resources are available in the college

82% of the respondents are of the opinion that student centric resources are available in the college. 9% of the respondents however disagree to the statement.




4. Classwork takes place as per schedule


5. Teaching aids are sufficient and up to date

All the departments in the college are able to supply sufficient and up to date teaching aids for the faculties and all the faculties who responded are satisfied with it




6. Library is utilised optimally by faculty

82% of the respondents are able to utilise the library optimally. However, 18% of the respondents have a neutral viewpoint to it.




7. Library is utilised optimally by students

Most of the teachers are of the viewpoint that students use the library optimally. 64% of the teachers agree to it, even though, 36% have a neutral opinion regarding it.




8. Teachers are supported with adequate learning resources

Teachers in the college are provided with adequate learning resources and 91% of the teachers are satisfied with the resources they have. 9% of the teachers expect improvement in this area.




9. Teachers are encouraged to carry out research


10. Teachers are encouraged to organise seminars/workshops/symposia/conferences

The college motivates the teachers to organise seminars, workshops etc. All the teachers are satisfied in this regard.




11. Teachers are encouraged to participate in seminars/workshops/symposia/conferences

All the teachers have the opportunity and freedom to participate in seminars, workshops etc for their growth. None of the teachers are dissatisfied in this regard.




12. Teachers are encouraged to undertake extension service programmes

All the teachers are satisfied with the opportunity and encouragement they receive to undertake extension service programmes.




13. Teachers are encouraged to take up consultancy services

82% of the respondents are of the opinion that they are encouraged to take up consultancy services. 9% of the respondents however do not agree to this statement.




14. The examination system followed by the university is effective


15. The evaluation system followed by the university is effective

82% of the teachers are satisfied with the way evaluation is performed in the university. 9% of the respondents however necessitate an improvement over the existing method of evaluation.




16. Internal examination system of the college is effective

17. Evaluation system of the college is effective


All the teachers are in support of the method of evaluation followed in the college. None of them require any improvement in this matter.



III. INFRASTRUCTURE


1. Classrooms and furniture available are adequate


2. Toilets are sufficient for faculty and students


3. Buildings and furniture are well maintained


4. Laboratories are adequately equipped


5. Infrastructure available in the department is optimally used

91% of the respondents are satisfied with the utilisation of the infrastructure available in the department. None of the teachers are dissatisfied in this regard.




6. Parking facilities are adequate

The college provides ample parking facilities and all the teachers are satisfied with the parking offered in the institution.




7. Roads are maintained

82% of the faculties who responded are satisfied with the adequacy of the water resources. 18% has a neutral view and none of them disagrees with it.




9. Safe drinking water is available

10. Adequate sports infrastructure


91% of the faculties are of the opinion that there is adequate sports infrastructure in the college. 9% of the respondents require better facilities in this regard.



IV. GOVERNANCE


1. The administration is sincerely putting efforts for the development of the institution

82% of the respondents are satisfied with the initiatives put in by the administration for the development of the college. None of them are dissatisfied in this respect.




2. The administration is accessible

Majority i.e. 82% of the faculties are of the view that the administration is easily accessible. They are satisfied in this respect. However, 9% expect better approachability from the administration.




3. Initiatives taken in the last academic year contributes to improvement

82% of the respondents are of the opinion that the initiatives taken up during the last academic year contributes to improvement. 9% however contradicts this statement.




4. MoUs entered by the college enhance mutual co-operation with institutions and research organisations

The college always encourage co-operative work environment with other institutions and research organisations. All the teachers are satisfied in this matter.




5. Faculties are given freedom to express opinion

All the teachers are pleased with the freedom they receive to express their opinion. None of them disagrees to this statement.




6. IQAC works well to promote quality in the institution

7. College provides adequate opportunities and support to faculties and their family


The college supports all the faculties and their family members. None of the teachers are displeased in this regard.


1. Whether proud to be an alumnus of Bishop Moore College

All the alumni who responded feel proud they were a part of the college. 92% strongly agree and 8% agree to the statement.




2. Learning received from college is useful for career

All the alumni respondents are satisfied with the learning they received from the college as it helped in the career.




3. Development of the college in the recent years is appreciative

College has developed in different ways in the recent years and all the alumni respondents are appreciative of this growth. None of them has expressed any dissatisfaction in this regard.




4. New courses introduced meet contemporary requirements

84% of the respondents are of the view that the new courses introduced meet the contemporary requirements. However, 8% expect a better change in this regard.




5. College involves alumni in its activities

The college always try to involve alumni in its activities. 84% of the alumni respondents are satisfied in this respect, However, 8% expect better involvement in the future years.




6. Alumni has a role to play in strengthening the college academically and financially


7. College actively communicates its activities to the alumni through social media.

84% of the respondents are of the opinion that the college communicates its activities to the alumni through social media. 8% of them expect better communication in the coming years.




1. Programme objectives and syllabi are challenging

Of the total number of employers who responded, 91% of them believes the programme and syllabito be challenging. 9% of them has a neutral view about it.




2. Objectives are clear and specific

82% of the respondents consider that the objectives of the various programmes and courses are clear and specific. They are satisfied in this regard. However, 9% of them expect better clarity in this matter.




3. Objectives are realistic

82% of the respondents are satisfied that the stated objectives of the programmes and courses are realistic. However, 9% of them expect an improvement in this regard.




4. Internal evaluation is done effectively

All the employers who responded are satisfied with the method adopted by the college for its internal evaluation. 91% of them has expressed their strong satisfaction.




5. Syllabus supports experiential learning

The syllabus followed by the college supports experiential learning. All the respondents are satisfied with the syllabus in this respect.




6. Skill development is given due importance in the syllabus
