Nature of Questionnaire:

The sample questionnaire is attached as Annexure I. The students were asked to mark their opinion on a 5-point scale. Feedback was collected on Curriculum, Infrastructure, Individual teachers and Effectiveness of Online Teaching. Suggestions on curriculum was asked for. Any other general suggestions were also sought.

Methodology Used in Analysis:


Likert scoring methodology was adopted. For each question on the questionnaire, the total number of responses for each sentiment level was found and respective weighted score was calculated. The totals received were divided by the total number of respondents:

Observations and Analysis:

I. TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS


1. The Adequateness of the curriculum:

The students were asked to mark their opinion regarding whether the curriculum was challenging, adequate, dull, inadequate, or irrelevant. 39.9% of the students were of the opinion that the syllabus was challenging and 56.5% of the students mentioned that the syllabus was adequate. All together 96% of students had the opinion that the curriculum is adequate or more than that.




2. Completion of Syllabus

The analysis of completion of syllabus showed that 51% of the students said that 91-100% of syllabus was completed and 86% of students mentioned that above 75% of syllabus was completed during their course of study. Only 14% of students marked that less than 75% of portions were completed.




3. Library Facilities

An analysis of the library facilities was made and 81.4 % of the students opinioned that the Library was Very Good. Only less than 8 % were mentioned Poor or very poor.




4. Internal Examination System


5. Student-Teacher Relationship in the Department

The response of student teacher relationship was healthy at department level. 94.6% of the students expressed that the teachers in departments kept good relationship with them.




6. Student-Teacher Relationship in the whole college

The response of student teacher relationship was good at College level. 77.8% of the students mentioned that the teachers kept good or Very Good relationship with students.




7. College Office Facilities

The response of office facilities was analyzed. 94.6% of the students said that office facilities were more than satisfied for their requirements.




8. Laboratory Facilities


9. Attitude of teachers to extra-curricular activities

The Attitude of teachers promoting extra-curricular activities was analyzed. 89.9% of the students said teachers were supporting extra-curricular activities.




10. Computer Facilities

The computer facilities were analyzed. 92.3% of the students mentioned that computer facilities are sufficient or better for meeting education requirements.




11. College Canteen

The college canteen facilities were analyzed. 25.6% of the students said than canteen needs improvement. 74.4% expressed satisfaction of the provided canteen facilities.




12. Sports Facilities

The sports facilities offered by college were analyzed. Only less than 10 % of the students were .dissatisfied and the others were satisfied.




13. Safety in the Campus

The Safety for students was analyzed. 90.5 % of students mentioned that safety measures taken by college were good or very good.




14. Environment Friendliness of Campus

The Environment Friendliness of Campus was analyzed. Majority (99.4%) of the students expressed their satisfaction for Eco-friendly campus.




15. How will you talk about the college?

Most of the students are pleased with the facilities of the class rooms and furniture provided at the college.

Majority of the students are agreeing that toilet provided at the college meets the requirements. A small minority points out the need for improvement.

Buildings and furniture are maintained

Majority of the students are agreeing that Maintenance of college properties is satisfactory.

Infrastructure available at the department are optimally used

A Large Number of the students are satisfied with infrastructure provided by departments at the college.

Parking Facilities are adequate

Most of the students are satisfied with Parking Facilities provided by the college

Roads are maintained well

Majority of the students are agreeing that roads are maintained well. A small group points out the need for some more maintenance.

Water resources are adequately provided

A Large Number of the students are satisfied with water resources available at the college.

Safe drinking water is available

Majority of the students are satisfied with safe drinking water provided available at the college. A few students were founded disagreeing to the same.

Important Findings:

- 1. Feedback on Curriculum: 96.3% of the students commented that the syllabus is adequate of which marked the syllabus to be challenging. Only 3.7% commented that the syllabus is inadequate or dull
- 2. Library Facilities: 80.9% commented that the library facilities are excellent. Only 8% commented that the library facilities are inadequate.
- 3. Internal Examination System: 100% students mentioned that the internal examination system is adequate.
- 4. The environment friendliness and safety in campus are marked exemplary.
- 5. The overall attitude of the students towards the college is highly positive.
- 6. Canteen Facilities need urgent upgradation
- 7. Sports and Ladies Hostel Facilities also require improvement.




OBSERVATIONS AND ANALYSIS



The responses received from Alumni were consistent with the responses from students. 97.7% commented that the syllabus is adequate. 72.7% marked that the learning they had was useful for their career. 84.9% strongly agreed that they are proud to be an alumnus of the college. The alumni suggested that the activities of the college has to be communicated to the alumni through social media to a larger extent.


