












Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 22nd November 2019 in the Principals Office at 2.30 p.m

1. It was decided to conduct CAS promotion screening committee for whom sanction has been granted within the prescribed time frame. The IQAC will take steps to organize the screening committee after screening the relevant documents of the teachers who have completed the requirements.
2. It was decided to organize the birth centenary celebration of Rev. George Mathen on 29th November 2019. The Minister for Higher Education in Kerala to inaugurate the meeting.


3. Mushroom culture was decided to be promoted in campus, as a value added programme. Mushroom culture to be inaugurated on 2nd December 2019 and training on Mushroom cultivation to be imparted to students, parents and public on 24th January 2020
4. Paper bag Training to be imparted to students as a value added programme, under the auspices of Bhoomitrasena.
5. The IQAC, in the auspices of StEP, decided to felicitate Asst. Prof. K Rekha, Dept. of Malayalam, who won the Kerala Sahithya Academy Award for Short stories on 13th January 2020

A National Seminar on 'Scientific Solutions for Sustainable Rebuilding of Kerala in the Post Flood Scenario' is to be organized by the Department of Physics, IQAC and DBT Star College Scheme in Association with the Directorate of Environment and Climate Change, Government of Kerala.
