Workshop on "Role of IPR in Academia and Industry: Department of Chemistry

The Department of Chemistry, Bishop Moore College, in collaboration with Intellectual Property Rights Information Centre (IPRIC-K), KSCSTE and Institution Innovation Council (IIC), organized a one-day Workshop on "Role of IPR in Academia and Industry" on 15th July 2025 with the objective of creating awareness about the relevance and application of intellectual property in the academic and research landscape. The workshop began with a solemn prayer song, followed by the Welcome Address delivered by Dr. Deepa Thomas, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry. The workshop was formally inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Ranjith Mathew Abraham, Principal, Bishop Moore College, who also delivered the Presidential Address. Annual Academic and Administrative Audit: Internal Quality Assurance Cell






Placement: Department of Physical Education
