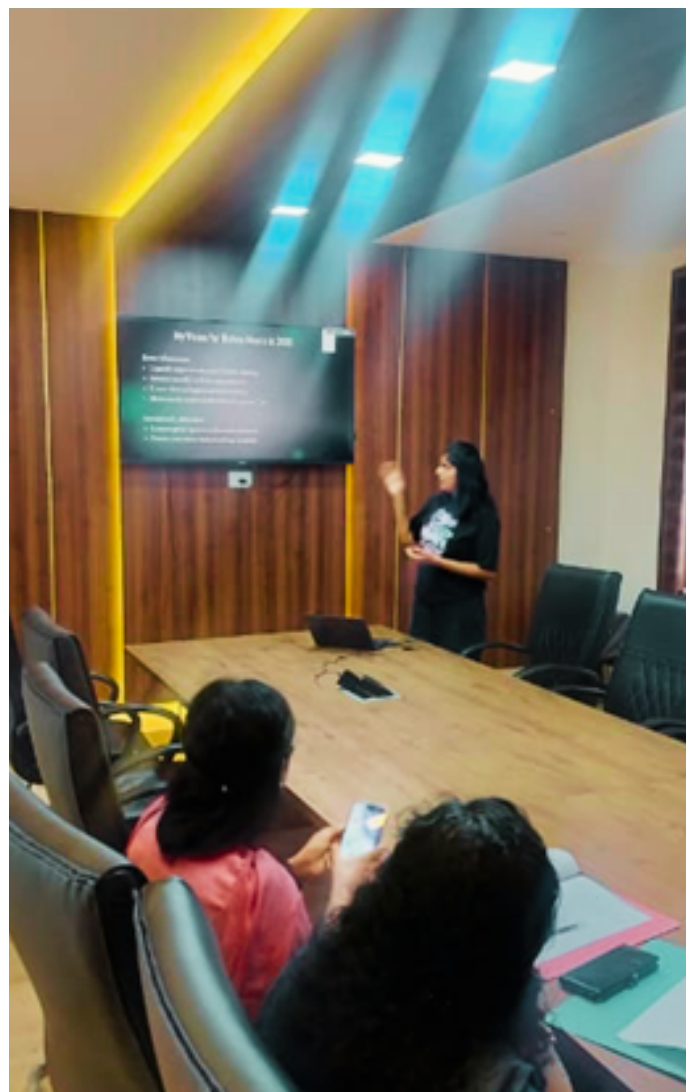
## Stars of Moore Contest

### Distribution of Low-Plastic Lifestyle Campaign Cloth Bags





### **Bishop Moore College shines at Asian School of Business!**

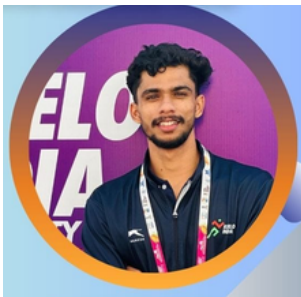

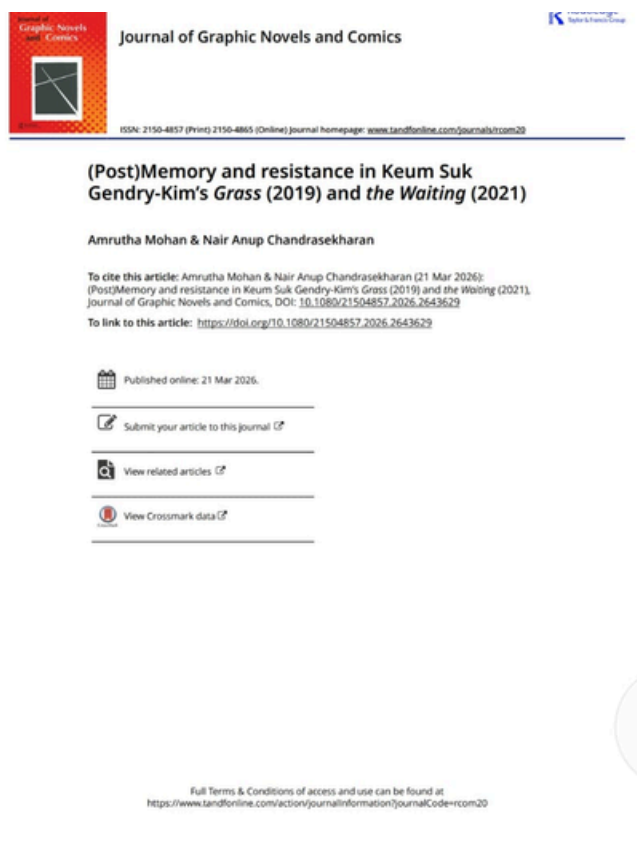


her invaluable contributions toward protecting nature and promoting sustainable living.

### Staff Chess and Table Tennis Tournament

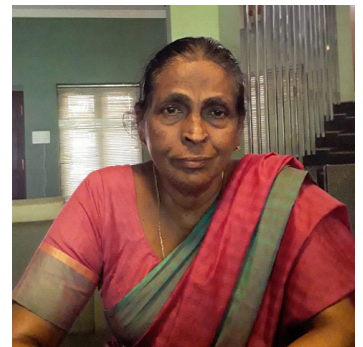
