NIRF RANKING 2018

Bishop Moore College made it to the top 100 colleges in India in the NIRF ranking 2018, released by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India in April 2018. The National Institutional Ranking framework (NIRF) outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. A Core Committee set up by MHRD had identified the parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation"

Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception".

Ranking Framework

The College was ranked ninety second in India (full scores of all the five parameters) and it bagged the sixteenth rank in Kerala. A notable achievement of the College is that it secured a rank of fifty three in India in the Research and Professional Practices category and was also ranked fifth in Kerala in terms of Research Productivity.





The Letter of Intent (LOI) was submitted to NAAC on 25 May 2016 and five hard copies of the Self Study Report were sent to NAAC in June 2016.

The Peer Team constituted by NAAC included Prof. S K Saidapur (Former Vice-Chancellor, Karnataka University), Prof. Sunita Kumbhat (Head, Dept. of Chemistry, Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur) and Dr. Deo Subhash Atmaram (Former Principal, Gogate Jogalikar College, Ratnagiri).

The Peer Team Visit was on 30 - 31 March 2017. The Peer Team took a genuine effort to understand the various aspects of the College through the presentations done by the Principal, IQAC Co-ordinator, Heads of the Departments, Librarian and Co-ordinators of the various activities of the College. The team spent much time and energy in visiting every Department and facility of the College, offering their commendation and challenging the College to progress further. The words of the Chairman of the peer team, Prof. S K Saidapur, warmed the hearts of all the faculty present in the exit meeting. He commended the Management, the IQAC and the faculty for their attempts towards building a quality system and offered the recommendations of the peer team to strive towards excellence.

The efforts put in by the College to consistently and continuously improve in all aspects emphasized by NAAC as well as the collective, dedicated and concerted efforts of all the stakeholders, facilitated by the IQAC and the NAAC Steering Committee, has resulted in the award of 'A' grade with a CGPA of 3.04 to the institution.
