Programme Structure

All Undergraduate Programmes follow Choice Based Credit and Semester System (CBCSS)



Core Course

Each Undergraduate Degree Programme has a Core Course of study, which will be offered by the Parent Department from the 1st semester onwards, and will include a project/dissertation to be undertaken during the 5th/6th semester



Complementary Courses

Two complementary courses will be offered for each Undergraduate Degree Programme which will be offered by the concerned departments in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th semesters



Language Courses & Foundation Courses

Language and Foundation Courses will be offered in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th semesters of all Undergraduate Degree Programmes by the Departments of English, Malayalam and Hindi



Open Courses

Students will have the option to do a course offered by any other department in the 5th semester of UG Degree Programme.



Elective Courses

Elective Courses will be offered by the parent department in the 6th semester of Undergraduate Degree Programme and in the 3rd and 4th semesters of Postgraduate Degree Programmes

Code of Conduct



Classes

Every student shall attend the classes regularly and punctually. When the Principal or teachers enter a classroom, students shall stand up and will remain standing till they are asked to sit down. Every student shall endeavor to conduct himself/herself in the classroom in such a manner as to afford the utmost possible assistance and cause the least disturbance to the work of the classes and to his/her fellow students.



Dress Code

Every student shall come clothed in a dignified dress. Women students shall wear churidar, sari, long skirt and blouse or mundum neryathum. Men students shall wear shirt and mund or shirt and pants. Students are expected to wear their student Identity Card inside the College campus.



Responsible Behaviour

All students are expected to co-operate with the College authorities in keeping the campus including classrooms, seminar halls, verandhas, premises, buildings and play grounds neat and tidy. Every student shall handle the College property with care and take care to maintain cleanliness and tidiness of the furniture, buildings and premises. Causing damage to the property is punishable.



General Discipline

Without the prior sanction of the Principal, students are not permitted (a) to convene or organize or attend meetings of any sort in any circumstance anywhere in the College buildings or premises (b) to set up entertainments or to organize social functions in the College buildings or premises (c) to make use of mega phones, loud speakers etc. in the College buildings or premises (d) to invite for any function in the College, persons who are not members of the Staff of the College (e) to collect subscriptions of any kind from members of the College (f) to put up any notice on any Notice Board in the College or elsewhere within the College building or premises (g) to place any paper, periodical or book in the reading room of the College or to circulate them in the College (h) to join work for any organization outside the College

Political activism is strictly banned in the campus. If students of the College are found to attend political or other meetings and conduct themselves in any manner which is forbidden or unbecoming to engage in political agitation in such a way as to interfere (in the opinion of the Principal) with the corporate life or educational work of the College, disciplinary action will be taken against them.

The use of mobile phones is restricted in the campus. Smoking, use of alcohol, drugs and psychotropic substance is strictly prohibited and a violation of the same would invite severe punishment.
