SCHOLARSHIP/ENDOWMENTS POLICY

Bishop Moore College Mavelikara has formulated a policy on the Disbursement of the following Scholarships/Free-ships/Endowments for students

- 1. Endowments instituted by Stake holders and well-wishers
- 2. Student Aid Fund from PD Account
- 3. Student Aid Fund from Staff

The Policy

- Scholarship selection committee is constituted every year by the principal of the college
 with a senior faculty member as the Convener and members from both teaching and
 non-teaching staff.
- 2. All scholarship applications received shall be scrutinized based on defined criteria by the scholarship selection committee in case of Institutional Scholarships of the college and as per the respective guidelines in case of those instituted by Government agencies.
- 3. The convener of the scholarship committee shall serve as the Nodal officer of the college for all Government Scholarship Schemes.
- 4. In case of Institutional Scholarships, an equitable distribution of scholarship should be ensured by the committee based on merit/s and promotion of a program, not compromising on the competitive merit and qualifications of the eligible candidate.
- 5. The scholarship committee shall develop a repository of open scholarships and institutions who consider award of scholarship to meritorious students, procedures to attract students with scholarship grants from other agencies/NGOs and, encourages students to apply for competitive scholarships/need based/merit based /governmental scholarships.
- 6. The applications for institutional scholarship should be forwarded by the Head of the Department.
- 7. Applications are to be thoroughly scrutinized and shortlisted under various categories.
- 8. Equal distribution of scholarships among all Departments is ensured by the Scholarship Committee.
- 9. The finalization of names is at the sole discretion of the committee members who take unbiased decisions.

- 10. Students who are found ineligible for the award on various factors are not considered for the same.
- 11. Award of scholarship also depends on availability of funds during that academic year.
- 12. Grievances, if any related to the application, selection and distribution shall be under the purview of the Student Grievances Redressal Cell.

List with Eligibility Criterion of the Institutional Endowments and Scholarships

1. ANNAMMA Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship shall be awarded annually to a student in undergraduate or postgraduate courses at the beginning of the academic year based on the previous academic year on a merit-cum-means basis, provide that the candidate chosen is keenly motivated to excel in studies. This means that only candidates from the second year of study are eligible.

This condition may however be relaxed if, in the opinion of the principal of the college, there is a highly deserving first year student whose financial disability is a cause for serious concern. This shall however be the exception rather than the rule.

2. P.I. CHERIAN Memorial Prize

Awarded to the student who secures first place for Moral Instruction Exam in the Senior Degree Class, and to the student who secures first place for Moral Instruction Exam in the Junior Degree Class.

3. MARY CHERIAN Memorial Prize

Awarded to the student who secure first place for Scripture exam in the Senior Degree Class, and to the student who secure first place for Scripture exam in the Junior Degree Class.

4. C.I. ABRAHAM Prize

Awarded to the first year B.A/B.Sc. student for proficiency in Scripture and to a first year B.A/B.Sc. student for proficiency in Moral Instruction.

5. KOCHUKALEECKAL K.C. KURIEN Memorial Prize

Prize as books to the final year B.A/B.Sc. student who gets first in Annual Scripture Exam.

6. THOPPIL MAJOR Dr. P.C. KOSHY Memorial Prize

60% of the interest will be utilized to give the first prize and 40% for second prize for the Painting Competition conducted annually by the college for the students of Bishop Moore College.

7. KANNUKUZHIYIL T. K. KURIEN Memorial Prize

Awarded as books to the student who secures first place in the final year University Exam of B.A. Degree (English Main) Main & Subsidiary papers.

8. GEORGE MATHEN Memorial Prize

Awarded to the student who secures first place in the final year University Exam of B.A. Degree (Malayalam Main).

9. K.V. JOSE Memorial Prize

Awarded as books to the student who secures second place in the final year University Exam of B.A. Degree (Malayalam Main).

10. SHEELA MARY PAUL Memorial Prize

Awarded as books to the student who secures second place in the final year University Exam of B.A. Degree (Economics Main){Core & Complimentary papers}.

11. S. KRISHNA IYER Memorial Gold Medal

Awarded to the student who secures first place in the final year University Exam of B.Sc. Degree (Mathematics Core){Core paper}.

12. KOCHUKALEECKAL Rev. K.K. CHACKO Memorial Prize

Awarded as books to the student who secures first place in the final year University Exam of B.Sc.Degree (Physics Main) {Main& Subsidiary papers}

13. ALUMOOTTIL LT. COL. DR. A.G. DAVID Memorial Prize

Awarded to the students who secure highest total marks in the final University Exam of M.Sc. Degree (Physics), B.Sc. Degree (Botany) and B.Sc. Degree (Chemistry) Awarded to three students

14. Prof. T.J. PHILIP Scholarship

Awarded to the student who secures highest total marks for B.Sc. Zoology.

15. SNEHARAJ Memorial Prize

Awarded to the student who secures highest mark in Part I &II (Language) of first and second year B.A/B.Sc. class.

16. GEORGE KANKALIL Memorial Prize

Awarded to the best all round student of the college.

17. ANANTHA SIVA IYER Prize

Awarded to the student of B.Sc. Degree who secures highest for Part I English.

18. INDO CANADIAN FRIENDSHIP AWARD

Awarded to first year Degree student belonging to the backward class securing highest marks in SSLC or equivalent exam.

19. C. K. JOHN Memorial Prize

Awarded annually to a poor and deserving student of the Degree Class who does not have any other scholarship or financial assistance.

20. KARUKAYIL ANNA THARIYAN Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a poor and deserving student of the first year Degree Class who completed +2 at Bishop Hodges High School, Mavelikara.

21. KONATTUKIZHAKKETHIL Mr. & Mrs. C.J. CHERIAN Award

Awarded annually to a poor and deserving girl student of the Degree first year class who does not have any other scholarship or financial assistance.

22. GEORGE KANKALIL Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a poor and deserving student of the first year Degree Class who is from Mavelikara Area. The scholarship will be available for three years provided his/her progress and conduct are satisfactory.

23. SARLADEVI MEMORIAL

Awarded to a student of final year B.A. (Economics) who secures highest marks at University Exam.

24. VALLAKKALIL Mr. K.O. MATHEW Scholarship

Awarded to a poor and deserving student of the college.

25. RACHEL AND ALEXANDER ITTYCHERIA Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a poor and deserving student of the first year Degree Class. The scholarship will be available for three years provided his/her progress and conduct are satisfactory.

26. POTHA PHILIP Memorial Prize

Awarded to a poor and deserving student of the college whose parent or guardian is a full-time worker of the Church of South India. The scholarship will be available for three years provided his/her progress and conduct are satisfactory.

Awarded to final year Degree student who secures highest marks for Part I English.

Three prizes for general proficiency awarded to students of Degree Class on the basis of total marks secured in all subjects in the first-year exam.

Awarded to a student who secures first place in the first year University Exam of B.A.(Economics).
