

Online Skill Training on Fabric Painting



very informative. He explained the technical aspects and aesthetic aspects of photography. 25 students attended the programme.




Online Interior Designing Class

The main objective of this tailoring training program is to enhance the quality of life of women students through enhancement of their skills and knowledge. This vocational skill can help them to earn more income and become economically self-sufficient and independent. Awareness talk on Personal hygiene and Self confidence

On 17 January 2023 an awareness talk on personal hygiene and self confidence class was organized by the Women's cell in association with Hindustan Unilever Limited and Rexona Confidence Academy. The aim of the class was to educate female students on the importance of personal hygiene and how it relates to self-confidence. The attendees were given tips on do's and don'ts in job interviews and also the benefits of regular exercise and a balanced diet. The class emphasized the role of personal hygiene in building self-confidence, and how good personal hygiene habits can positively impact a woman's overall well-being. The class was taken by Ms. Anjuman Bhanu, a well known Personality Development Trainer, Master of Ceremony and Make-up Artist. Free Rexona roll ons were provided to all women on campus. Ms. Anne Angeline Abraham presided over the meeting. 70 women students participated in the programme.



Ashakiranam Cancer Care Campaign

A Cancer Awareness Class, Cancer Detection and Hair donation camp was conducted in association with Anugraha Social Service Society on 21st January 2023. The Cancer Awareness class was handled by Dr. Besty A., Senior Resident, Department of Community Medicine, Pushpagiri Medical College, Thiruvalla. As the majority of students who attended the session were women, the importance of early breast cancer detection and ways by which one can self evaluate the onset of breast cancer was also discussed in detail. The day's event was focused on creating awareness about cancer in women and early cancer detections. A team of doctors from Department of Community Medicine, Pushpagiri Medical

College, Thiruvalla did a cancer detection camp for 50 women; both students and staff. It included Breast Cancer Detection, Oral Cancer Detection and Thyroid Cancer Detection. There was also a Hair donation camp conducted on the same day. Six students from our college volunteered to donate for the cause. The programme was an overall success.



Talk on Legal Awareness for the Protection of Women and Children

A legal awareness class was arranged on 7th February 2023 for the protection of women and children. The purpose of the class was to educate and create awareness among women and children about their legal rights and the available legal remedies for protection against abuse, violence, and exploitation. The topics covered included domestic violence, sexual harassment, child abuse, child labor, and trafficking. The participants gained a better understanding of the laws and their rights and felt more empowered to seek legal help in

case of any violation. The class was taken by Adv. Sherin Achu Ninan, Advocate at Ernakulam High Court. Around 30 students participated.



PATHFINDER: Two day workshop on Personal and Professional Excellence

On 22 and 23 February 2023 a Two day workshop towards Personal and Professional Excellence class was organized by the women's cell in association with Synergy HR solutions. The workshop was conducted by a team of experts who covered various topics related to personal and professional development. The topics covered included time management, communication skills, goal setting, leadership skills, and personal branding. The workshop was successful in creating awareness among girl students about the importance of personal and professional development. Four trainers from Synergy HR solutions handled various sessions. 50 students attended the training.













Women's Day Celebration and Self Defense training program

A self-defense program was organized for girl students on Women's day (08th March,2023) by Janamaithri Police, Mavelikara to help them learn essential self-defense techniques and to empower them to protect themselves from potential threats. The experts provided hands-on training to the participants and covered various self-defense techniques like punches, kicks, and escapes from grabs. The program was designed to teach the participants how to defend themselves in real-life situations and to increase their confidence and self-esteem.
