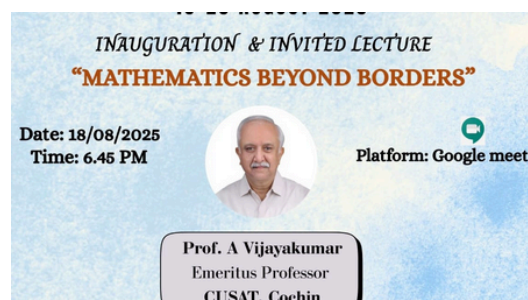

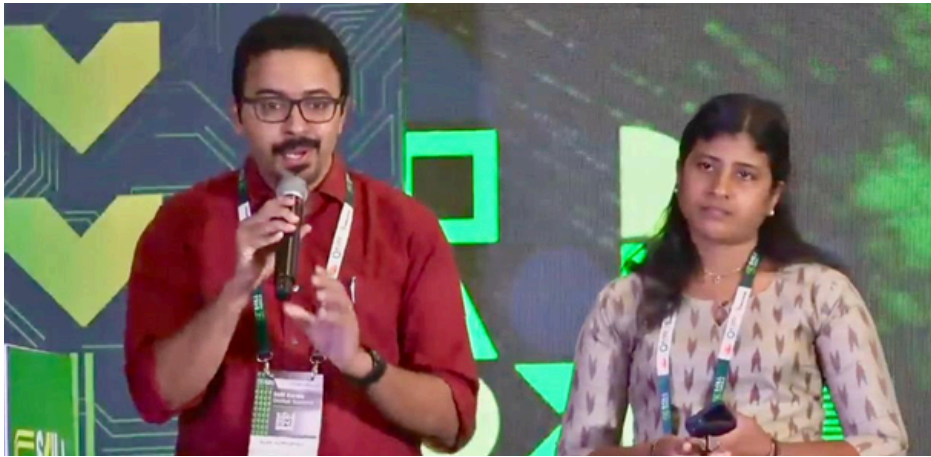
UG and PG students and Research scholars attended the lecture. The session was followed by an interction session.
